



- BOSS video game committee conducted their first Video Game tournament. More than **30 soldiers** participated including **10 volunteers**



QR Code Scam Alert

■ Fake Parking Warning Stickers with QR Code

Typical Sticker (Simple Warning For Parking)




- Parking warning stickers are simply warnings issued by private property owners (such as apartments, stores, etc.).
- **These stickers do not hold any legal enforcement power and cannot impose fines.**
- Traffic tickets issued by authorities are typically mailed to the address on record. (Toll fees may be sent via text)
- Note that if you don't have a Korean credit card or a Korean bank account, payment for fines is only available in person at banks or post offices.
- Scanning a QR code on a fake sticker could lead to **downloading malicious software or redirecting to phishing sites designed to steal payment information.**





QR Code Scam Aert

- Attaching a fake QR code, on top of the official QR code



When renting public bikes or PTDs, always ensure that you **download the official application** provided by the rental service, **scan QR through the official app**. If the QR code is fake, it likely won't work with the official app.

Before scanning it, ensure to verify if it's placed on top of a genuine QR code.

QR Code Scam Prevention Tips


- Avoid scanning QR codes from dubious sources.
- Take extra caution when scanning QR codes in public areas.
- Limit app installations from unknown sources in your phone device settings.





Nationwide Increase in Vehicle Burglary

- Increase in vehicle burglary **targeting cars with unfolded side mirrors**



- In Korea, instead of smashing the windows to steal, thieves usually target cars with the unfolded side mirror, because **they see it as a signal that the car might be unlocked.**
- Always lock the door and fold side mirrors when leaving the car.






Minimum CDC Canine U.S. Importation Requirements Starting 01 AUG 2024:

- Appear healthy upon arrival
- Be at least six months of age
- Be microchipped
- Be accompanied by a *CDC Dog Import Form* online submission receipt

**Additional requirements are based on where the dog has been in the last six months and whether or not the dog was vaccinated in the United States*




