## NEW Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Dog Importation Rules to the U.S.

**ANY dog entering the United States starting 01 AUG 2024 MUST:**

- Be at least 6 months of age
- Appear healthy upon arrival
- Have ISO compliant microchip
- Have a *CDC Dog Import Form* receipt
- Have an air waybill if arriving by air
- Have additional rabies vaccination or veterinary documentation on hand\*

*\*Additional requirements are based on where the dog has been in the last six months and whether or not the dog received rabies vaccine in the United States*

## CDC Canine Import Requirements to U.S. starting 01 AUG 2024: *What We Know for Dogs Leaving Korea*

### Owner Responsibilities:

- Ensure dog is old enough to enter U.S.
- Keep up-to-date on rabies vaccine and microchip
  - Microchip must be implanted before first rabies vaccine
- Fill out the **CDC Dog Import Form** online 2-10 days before arrival to U.S. port of entry
  - Include clear photograph showing dog's face and body
  - Arrive at location listed on the form
- Present the following documents to import officer:
  - **Certification of U.S. Issued Rabies Vaccine Form**
  - +/- **USDA endorsed export health certificate**
  - Air waybill if traveling by air (provided by airlines based off info from owner at ticket counter)
- *Contact Veterinary Services as soon as possible to set up individual PCS timeline requirements*

### Army Veterinary Services Can Provide:

- Rabies vaccine that counts as vaccinated in the U.S.
- ISO microchip implantation and validation
- Endorsement of **Certification of U.S. Issued Rabies Vaccine Form** for dogs vaccinated in the U.S. or at OCONUS military Veterinary Treatment Facility
- **USDA endorsed export health certificate**
- Further guidance for owners with dogs that received rabies vaccination off-post from Korean civilian veterinarians






**Mission:** The Hazardous Material Control Point (HMCP) provides logistical support for the management of hazardous materials that enter the installation.
