
- Need-based scholarship through AER for spouses & surviving spouses of Army Soldiers (active duty, retired, or Title 10 Guard/Reserve).

[Punishment for Psychotropic Substance Offenses]

Synthetic Marijuana (Class A)

- (a) Use/Possession ⇒ at least 1 year of imprisonment
- (b) Sale/Purchase/Smuggling ⇒ life imprisonment or a minimum of 5 years

Alkyl Nitrite (Class B)

- (a) Use/Possession ⇒ Up to 10 years of imprisonment or a fine of up to 100 million
- (b) Sale/Purchase ⇒ Same as above
- (c) Smuggling/Manufacture ⇒ Life imprisonment or a minimum of 5 years

[Recent Cases]

- •SEP 2023 Pyeongtaek: 17 U.S. soldiers were charged with smuggling liquid synthetic marijuana through APO and selling it.
- •APR 2025 Asan: A U.S. soldier came under KNP investigation for purchasing and using liquid synthetic marijuana.
- •JUN 2025 Pyeongtaek: A U.S. soldier came under KNP investigation for selling liquid synthetic marijuana on base.







Public Health: Malaria Awareness & Prevention Pt. 1

Malaria in Korea

- It is a preventable summer health risk that occurs primarily north of Seoul near the DMZ in rural areas.
- Less than 10 cases recently of Soldiers contracting Malaria during training near the DMZ.
- No cases of dependents/civilians. No cases outside of training grounds near DMZ.
- Malaria rates have been steadily declining over the years.
 Overall malaria infection rates remain low (<0.1%) IN
 MOST OF South Korea.
- The areas for highest risk of malaria transmission are in rural areas in Area 1 (near the DMZ) but still remain less than 1%.

Public Health: Malaria Awareness & Prevention Pt. 2

What is Malaria?

- Malaria is an infectious disease transmitted to humans by the bite of an infective mosquito.
- These mosquitos commonly bite during dusk to dawn.
- The peak season is typically from 1 May to 1 November.

Malaria Symptoms

- Early onset: For approximately 30% of individuals Malaria symptoms appear within in 7-21 days.
- Delayed: In 70%, symptoms are delayed and appear between 6-18 months after being bitten.
- Four symptoms are always present:
 - Sudden onset of Chills
 - 2. Followed by Fever
 - Then Intense Sweats that last 2-6 hours
 - 4. Followed by **Fatigue**
- Other common symptoms may include: Vomiting, Diarrhea, Headache, Nausea

MALARIA RISK IN KOREA Have you traveled to a malaria risk area (rural region near the DMZ NO along the border of North Korea) within the last 12 months? 
How to Prevent? Follow DoD Insect Repellent System

Personal protection is the key to malaria prevention.

- 1. Apply Repellent on exposed skin
- 2. Properly wearing uniforms treated with permethrin
- 3. Use treated bed nets when sleeping outdoors near DMZ
- Commanders should ensure Soldiers have full personal protective measures available before Soldiers train in areas north of Seoul.
- Unit supply should have personal protection items on hand and issue them to Soldiers when they train at malaria high-risk areas.
