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

As **PEAK SEASON** approaches, it is imperative that you take the necessary steps to prepare for your PCS. If you are scheduled to PCS within the next 90 days, please note the following:

- **Schedule Your Pre-Move Out Inspection:** Ensure you schedule your pre-move out inspection with the Housing Office at least **30 days before** your departure. You do not need orders to complete this step.
- **Final Joint Move-Out Inspection:** When scheduling your pre-inspection, you may also arrange your final joint move-out inspection. A copy of your orders will be required for this process, so please provide them as soon as they become available.
- **TLA Authorization:** E7 and above residing in SLQs are authorized three (3) days of TLA. Please plan your flight, move-out inspection, and hotel accommodations accordingly, as extensions will not be granted. NOTE: This does not apply if you are in TDY, Rotational Unit, Reservist

PROXY Memorandum: If you are unable to complete the out-processing procedures for SLQs in a timely manner, you are required to submit a Proxy Memorandum. This memorandum must be signed by your BDE CDR (O6) and should assign a designated individual to properly out-process on your behalf. Be advised that failing the final inspection may result in financial charges to restore the room to standard.

We appreciate your attention to these guidelines and your cooperation in ensuring a smooth PCS process.

Command Policy #41 - Ownership and control of pets

According to Command Policy #41, section 6.B: Pet ownership in Unaccompanied Personnel Housing (UPH) to include Senior Leaders Quarters (SLQ) **is forbidden**.

The only exception to this policy is for units that have a unit mascot (such as a dog). It is the chain of command's responsibility to ensure that mascot animals receive proper housing and care.

- ✓ **1. Pet Waste Disposal:** Clean up after your pets immediately. Clean up waste as it occurs, and always bring extra baggies or use what is provided at pet disposal stations
- ✓ **2. Indoor Cleanliness:** Prevent pets from relieving themselves in public areas. Clean up accidents promptly.
- ✓ **3. Public Etiquette:** Train pets to behave well in public. Avoid excessive barking and ensure pets are non-threatening.
- ✓ **4. Leash Use:** Always keep pets on a leash outside.
- ✓ **5. Noise Control:** Manage and minimize excessive pet noise.
- ✓ **6. Responsible Indoor Maintenance:** You are responsible for any damages caused by your pets.
- ✓ **7. Pet Walking:** Only responsible individuals should walk pets. Ensure the walker can manage the pet's size and strength.
- ✓ **Command Policy 41: Dogs will be leashed and controlled by an individual 12 years of age or older whenever dogs are outside of an owner's dwelling unit.**

- 1. This policy establishes procedures for mediating complaints and resolving policy violations in Army Family Housing (AFH) and Senior Leader Quarters (SLQ) at Camp Humphreys and K-16.
- 2. Housing Office is responsible for mediating resident complaints regarding violations of housing policy, including noise, pets, parking, smoking, and fire safety.
- 3. If issues cannot be resolved among individuals, the matter may be brought before the Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB) for review, or the Garrison Commander may direct a preliminary inquiry IAW AR 15-6.
- 4. All residents of AFH and SLQ are required to adhere to housing policies and guidelines, and applicable fire and safety policies. This includes policies related to noise, pets, parking, smoking, and fire safety. Residents who repeatedly violate policies, disturbing the peace and harmony of the housing areas and Senior Leader Quarters, may be considered for housing termination.

The following guidelines will be used to resolve policy violations:

- 1st Violation: A written notice will be sent to the sponsor.
- 2nd Violation: A written notice will be sent to the sponsor and the sponsor's chain-of-command.
- 3rd Violation: A written notice will be sent to the sponsor and the sponsor's chain-of-command. This notice may include penalties directed by the Garrison Commander, a directive to appear in front of the AFDCB, or notification that the Garrison Commander will initiate a preliminary inquiry.

Hit and Run Cases

■ Mandatory Actions for Drivers After a Traffic Accident

1	Stop immediately and check the situation.
2	Providing aid to any injured persons, including reporting the accident to the police (Dial 112).
3	Providing the victim with your name and contact information.

★ Failure to perform any of these actions may lead to hit-and-run charges.

■ Situations That Could Be Treated as Hit-and-Run

- Leaving the scene without providing your personal information — even if the victim says “I’m fine, you can go”
- Pedestrian injured after being startled by the vehicle (even without direct contact), and the driver leaves without taking proper action
- Taking the victim to a hospital but failing to provide your personal information

■ Types of Hit-and-Run Cases & Legal Penalties

Scenario	Penalty
Hitting a parked vehicle (minor damage such as scratches or dents)	Fine of up to 200,000 KRW
Collision with a moving vehicle	Imprisonment of 5 year or less, or fine of up to 15 million KRW
Injury to the victim	Imprisonment of 1 year or more, or fine between 5 million and 30 million KRW
Death of the victim	Life imprisonment, or imprisonment of at least 5 years



MEDPROS: NCAT Testing Program

New MEDPROS Requirement - NCAT

All Soldiers on peninsula are currently marked “red” in MEDPROS for NCAT, which stands for Neuro-Cognitive Assessment Tool. This is a new mandatory requirement under the DoD Monitoring Program (CMP).

8th Army, 65th MED BDE, and BDAACH are jointly working to establish the NCAT Testing Program at the Medical Readiness Clinic at Maude Hall.

An official announcement will be made once the NCAT Testing Program is fully stood up and operational.

What is NCAT?

It is DoD policy that all Service members and DoD civilian employees across the deployment cycle will undergo computerized neurocognitive assessment testing. Neurocognitive assessment tools (NCATs) are used to screen for changes in cognitive status over time.



What is ANAM?

The Automated Neuropsychological Assessment Metrics (ANAM) is the DoD-designated neurocognitive assessment tool until evolving science and medical best practices inform a change in policy. It is one of several commercially available neurocognitive tools consisting of a library of computer-based assessments of cognitive domains including attention, concentration, reaction time, memory, processing speed, and decision-making.


PCSing with Pets from Korea:

CONUS

- Rabies Vaccine with Rabies Certificate (dogs & cats)
 - ISO Compliant Microchip and its number listed on all required documents (dogs & cats)
 - Health Certificate (dogs & cats)
 - ROK Inspection Certificate (dogs & cats)
 - CDC Dog Import Form (requirement only for dogs)
 - > 6 months old of age (requirement only for dogs)
 - Appears healthy upon arrival (dogs & cats)
- Consult with Veterinary Services as soon as possible if your dog has visited a rabies high-risk country within the 6 months before arriving to the U.S. as additional requirements apply.

OCONUS:

- Rabies Vaccine with Rabies Certificate (dogs & cats)
- ISO Compliant Microchip and its number listed on all required documents (dogs & cats)
- Valid FAVN (dogs & cats)
- Health Certificate (dogs & cats)
- ROK Inspection Certificate (dogs & cats)
- Quarantine Notification/Entry Permit Request (dogs & cats)
- Proof of Additional Vaccines/Parasite Treatment
 - DAPv, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Bordetella (dogs)
 - FVRCP, FeLV (cats)
 - Endo/Ectoparasites (dogs & cats)






Summer Pet Safety Tips

- Risk for heat injury/heat stroke increases when:
 - Ambient temp is > 80F
 - High humidity
 - Pet is not acclimated to heat/exercise
 - Brachycephalic breeds (Bulldogs, Pugs, Boxers, Persians, etc)
- DO NOT leave pets unattended in a parked car.
- DO NOT leave your pet unsupervised outside on a hot day.
- Assess if pavement is too hot for your pet's paws by placing your hand on the pavement for five seconds.
- Avoid strenuous exercise during hottest times of the day
- Provide access to fresh, cool water frequently
- Provide shade/shelter from direct sunlight.



- Book a direct flight to destination when possible, avoid layovers
- Travel early morning or late evening
- Use a proper size IATA compliant crate.
- Familiarize your pet with the travel carrier prior to travel date
- Ensure pet crate has proper identification
- Inform airline employees when you board that you are traveling with a pet



IF YOU SUSPECT PET HEAT INJURY:

- Signs of heat injury: weakness, vomiting, diarrhea, dull mentation, uncontrollable panting, drooling, stumbling, seizures, collapse
- Move your pet out of direct heat
- Offer fresh, cool water if your pet is alert and willing to drink
- Spray your pet with cool water
- Immediately take your pet to a veterinarian for further care



AFSBn-Korea CIF Out-Processing

❑ Requirement for clearing CIF:

- Installation Clearance Record (DA Form 137-2) or civilian equivalent
- PCS Orders or Exception To Policy Memo signed by unit commander
- Military Identification Card or Common Access Card
- All SMs must be in military attire (PTs and civilian clothing are unauthorized)
- All OCIE must be cleaned, in good condition, and serviceable at the time of Turn-In

❑ Verify clothing record before coming to CIF

- Access clothing records at the following URL:
https://ism.army.mil/ism/SelfServiceServlet?nav.nav_id=ssMyClothing
- The PCS / ETS columns will annotate non-transferrable items with an “N” (These items MUST be Turned-In to receive a clearance stamp on Installation Clearance Record, DA Form 137-2)

❑ Additional Notes

- It is suggested to conduct a 100% OCIE inventory prior to arriving at CIF to avoid unexpected costs and delays due to missing items. Report any lost or damaged OCIE to Commander prior to arriving at the CIF
- Acceptable documents to account for missing items are as follows:
 - DD Form 200, Financial Liability Investigation for Property Loss (FLIPL)
 - DA Form 7923, Statement of Charges (SOC) or Cash Collection (CC)
- CIF hours of operation for Turn-In are Mon - Thurs 1300 - 1600 at BLDG P6950

VMIS: Search for “volunteer for buses” to register as a volunteer.


