Dear Residents,

Please adhere to the following guidelines regarding pet etiquette and cleanliness:

- **v1. Pet Waste Disposal**: <u>Clean up after your pets immediately.</u>
- **v2. Indoor Cleanliness**: <u>Prevent pets from relieving themselves</u> in public areas. Clean up accidents promptly.

V3. Public Etiquette: <u>Train pets to behave well in public Avoid excessive</u> barking and ensure pets are non-threatening.

- V4. Leash Use: Always keep pets on a leash outside.
- **V5.** Noise Control: Manage and minimize excessive pet noise.
- V6. Responsible Indoor Maintenance: You are responsible for any

damages caused by your pets.

V7. Pet Walking: Only responsible individuals should walk pets. Ensure the walker can manage the pet's size and strength.

V Command Policy 41: Dogs will be leashed and controlled by an

individual 12 years of age or older whenever dogs are outside of an owner's

dwelling unit.

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Dear Residents,

Smoking is strictly prohibited in Unaccompanied Housing facilities, including Barracks and Senior Leader Quarters (SLQs). This policy applies to private rooms as well as common areas such as parking garages, entryways, stairwells, hallways, balconies, and elevators. Please note, this restriction includes the use of both cigarettes and e-cigarettes.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in respecting your neighbors and adhering to this policy. If you must smoke, please do so outside in designated smoking areas located at least 50 feet away from the building. Additionally, please avoid discarding cigarette butts on the ground and ensure you clean up after yourself.

Important Reminder: Smoking in your can cause smokerelated damage and may trigger a fire response. There have been multiple incidents where smoking-related accidents led to fire emergencies. Additionally, during your PCS final join inspection, any smoke damage found may result in financial charges to restore the room to its original condition.

Senior Leader Quarters (SLQ) Residents,

As **PEAK SEASON** approaches, it is imperative that you take the necessary steps to prepare for your PCS. If you are scheduled to PCS within the next 90 days, please note the following:

• Schedule Your Pre-Move Out Inspection: Ensure you schedule your pre-move out inspection with the Housing Office at least <u>**30 days before**</u> your departure. You do not need orders to complete this step.

• **Final Joint Move-Out Inspection:** When scheduling your pre-inspection, you may also arrange your final joint move-out inspection. A copy of your orders will be required for this process, so please provide them as soon as they become available.

• **TLA Authorization:** E7 and above residing in SLQs are authorized three (3) days of TLA. Please plan your flight, move-out inspection, and hotel accommodations accordingly, as extensions will not be granted. NOTE: This does not apply if you are in TDY, Rotational Unit, Reservist

PROXY Memorandum: If you are unable to complete the out-processing procedures for SLQs in a timely manner, you are required to submit a Proxy Memorandum. This memorandum must be signed by your BDE CDR (O6) and should assign a designated individual to properly out-process on your behalf. Be advised that failing the final inspection may result in financial charges to restore the room to standard.

We appreciate your attention to these guidelines and your cooperation in ensuring a smooth PCS process.

Designated Parking Requests

- Units requesting designated parking must follow the steps outlined below:
- Contact the Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) Traffic Section (DSN: 755-9925 / 9928).
- DES Traffic Section will only do a parking lot assessment if the requestor is wanting **more than 5%** of the overall parking lot area for designated parking. This will require an Exception To Policy (ETP) that will require the Traffic Section to assess the parking lot overall, along with guidance with the ADA and ABA acts along with **Command Policy #14 (Installation Parking)**.
- If the requested area is under the 5% there is no need for an Exception To Policy (ETP) or assessment.
- Upon completion of the assessment, the DES Traffic Section will show how many handicapped stalls are required if area is not in tolerance. After completion of identification, 5% of the remaining stalls will be calculated and presented as the allowance for designated parking.
- Once complete, DES will then forward the findings and designation recommendations to the Garrison Commander for approval, and upon receipt determination will be made.
- If approved, proceed through Directorate of Public Works to begin the project.
