Senior Leader Quarters (SLQ) Residents,

As **PEAK SEASON** approaches, it is imperative that you take the necessary steps to prepare for your PCS. If you are scheduled to PCS within the next 90 days, please note the following:

• Schedule Your Pre-Move Out Inspection: Ensure you schedule your pre-move out inspection with the Housing Office at least <u>30 days before</u> your departure. You do not need orders to complete this step.

• **Final Joint Move-Out Inspection:** When scheduling your pre-inspection, you may also arrange your final joint move-out inspection. A copy of your orders will be required for this process, so please provide them as soon as they become available.

• **TLA Authorization:** E7 and above residing in SLQs are authorized three (3) days of TLA. Please plan your flight, move-out inspection, and hotel accommodations accordingly, as extensions will not be granted. NOTE: This does not apply if you are in TDY, Rotational Unit, Reservist

PROXY Memorandum: If you are unable to complete the out-processing procedures for SLQs in a timely manner, you are required to submit a Proxy Memorandum. This memorandum must be signed by your BDE CDR (O6) and should assign a designated individual to properly out-process on your behalf. Be advised that failing the final inspection may result in financial charges to restore the room to standard.

We appreciate your attention to these guidelines and your cooperation in ensuring a smooth PCS process.

Warm Weather Awareness – Grill Safety

- Grills are not authorized for use inside buildings or on balconies – including in Army Family Housing
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup
- Never leave your grill unattended when in use
- Do not dump hot coals; completely extinguish coals before dumping or dispose in a metal container to cool
- Gas grills are involved in over 9,000 home fires per year; Leaks or breaks was the primary problem with gas grills during these incidents
- July was the peak month for grill fires (16%), followed by June (14%), May (12%) and August (11%)
- 20% of all Grill Fires are the result of grills not properly being cleaned

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(*New*) Penalties for Possession of Dangerous Weapons in Public Places

Background

The number of random attacks involving knives in public areas has been increasing. However, since existing laws failed to effectively prevent such cases, a new provision was introduced to deter people from carrying weapons in public places.

Legal Provision <Starting April 8th, 2025>

Article 116-3 (Possession of Dangerous Weapons in Public Places), Criminal Act Anyone who, without a justifiable reason, possesses a dangerous weapon capable of harming another person's life or body and causes fear or anxiety by exposing it in a public place shall be subject to:

Imprisonment for up to 3 years, or a fine of up to 10 million KRW.

Key Notes

- The term "justifiable reason" may include situations where individuals need to carry such items for work-related purposes, such as cooking, delivery, or construction, or when they are en route to activities like camping or fishing. However, self-defense may not be regarded as a justifiable reason unless there is clear and reasonable necessity.
- The term "dangerous weapon" is not limited to knives. It includes any object that could cause physical harm such as broken bottles, sharp tools, or other improvised weapons. Whether an object is considered a dangerous weapon will depend on how it is used and the circumstances involved.











(*Alert*) Vehicle Break-In : Suspects Targeting Unlocked Cars



Recent Case

On March 14, 2025, a vehicle break-in occurred in the underground parking lot of EG The 1 Apartment in Asan, where many SOFA members reside. Two suspects broke into several unlocked vehicles — including **seven belonging to SOFA members**.



Thieves often check **unfolded side mirrors** as an indicator that the vehicle **may be unlocked**, since most cars in Korea automatically fold their mirrors when locked.

Always lock your car and make sure the side mirrors are folded when leaving your vehicle.
