

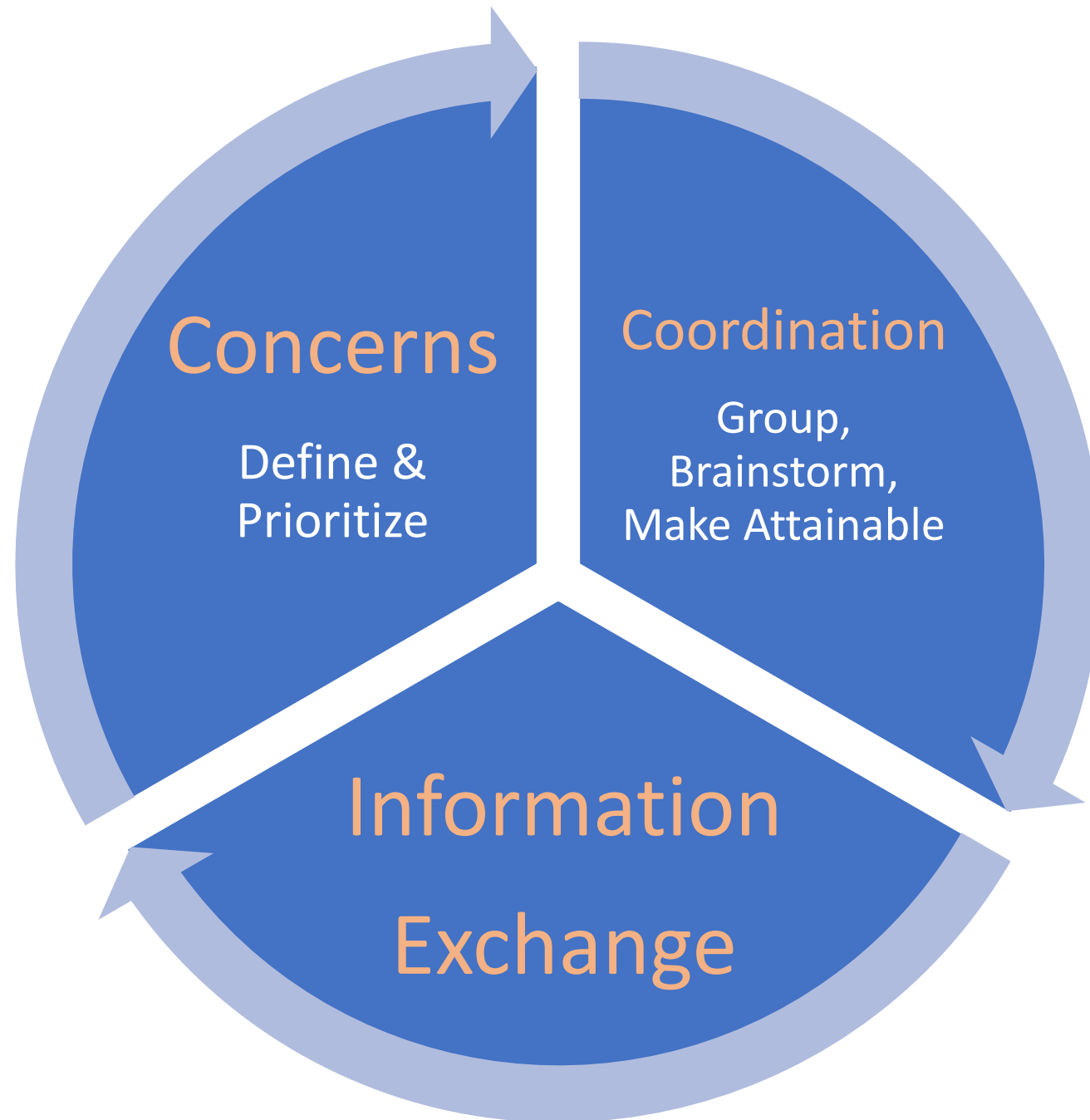


The goal of LICC is to:

The LICC mission is to ensure communication and collaboration among family support agencies in meeting the needs and addressing concerns of children (ages birth to 5 years old) with disabilities and their families. It is mandated by the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) and Public Law 102-119. In addition, MED-COM Reg. 40-53 provides guidance in overseas military communities.

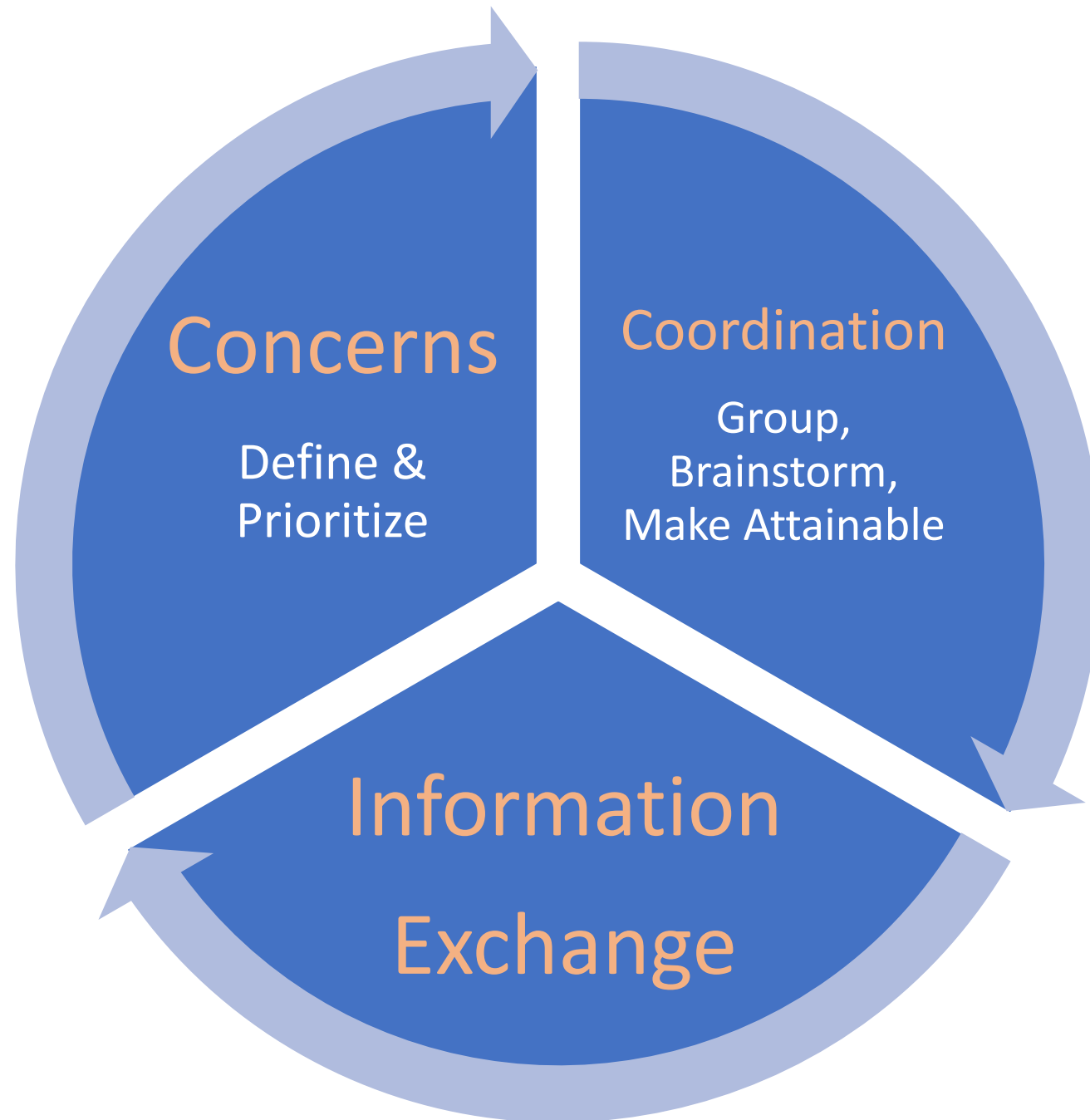
