## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Command Policy #49, Licensing Explosives Storage Areas -Area III

- 1. References:
  - a. AR 385-10, Army Safety Program
  - b. AK 385-10, Eighth Army Safety Program
  - c. DA PAM 385-30, Risk Management
  - d. DA PAM 385-64, Ammunition and Explosives Safety Standards
- 2. IAW DA PAM 385-64, when outside the United States comply with host nation (HN), multinational, or U.S. explosives safety standards, whichever are more stringent, unless standards applicability is mandated by international agreement.
- 3. The Garrison Commander will license explosives storage for every separate location where authorized for storage of Class V items in USAG Humphreys and Area III. Explosives storage licenses can be more restrictive than the Department of Defense Explosives Safety Board (DDESB) explosives safety site plan upon which they maybe based but cannot exceed the net explosive weight (NEW) or hazard classes of ammunition.
- 4. Licensing procedures are based on DA PAM 385-64. Units coordinate with installation elements (physical security, fire protective services, QASAS, and surveillance) to determine appropriateness of proposed sites, operating procedures and limitations using USAG Humphreys and Area III Safety Office Form (AMIM-HM Form 46). Once coordination has been completed, forward the USAG Humphreys Explosives License Packet to the USAG-H Safety Office for review. The USAG-H Safety Office has been delegated approval or disapproval authority.
