


DPW Housing – HOLIDAY LIGHTING GUIDELINES

Balcony/Exterior of Residences

Everyone loves to decorate during the holiday season! Especially during the holidays, it is extremely important to be aware of fire dangers. **DO NOT overload electrical outlets.**

- **All Halloween lights must be removed NLT 7 November.**
- **Christmas lights will be removed NLT 15 January 2025.**
- **Outside decorative lights are to be turned off by 2200 nightly, except on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, when they are allowed to remain on overnight.**
- ***All lights must be turned off during daylight hours!***





Prepare your vehicle for the winter.

Winterize your car
Check antifreeze, defroster, heater, lights, oil, tires, windshield washer fluid, and wiper blades

Have emergency supplies in your car

Snow Chains, Blanket, jumper cables, first aid kit, Spare batteries, flashlight, ice scraper, sand/gravel, small shovel and a cellular phone

Before you drive

Warm up your car for a few minutes
Clean the entire car – remove snow & ice from (lights, bumpers, hood, trunk and roof of vehicle. Make sure all lights are operational & test brakes.



Maintain “SPACE”

Speed - The No. 1 cause of Winter driving accidents is driving to fast.

Patience and courtesy save lives.

Awareness of other vehicles and your environment is essential.

Concentration - The increased hazards of winter driving make this important.

Exit - Always leave yourself an out.

While you are driving –

Follow vehicles at a safe distance
Increase distance if you are driving in snow or snow-packed road.

Gently tap and release brake pedal in a pumping motion (Non-ABS vehicle only).

Vehicles with ABS/disk brakes should apply steady, gentle pressure to the pedal

- Do not pump ABS brakes.

Safe Driving Skills

Skids – Steer in direction of skid

As the vehicle comes out of the skid, straighten wheels or steer slightly in the opposite direction as necessary to maintain control of vehicle.

When Stuck –

Watch out for other cars!

Shovel the snow from the front & back of all wheels, spread sand, salt or kitty litter.

Try to ease out without spinning the wheels –

Keep wheels aligned straight until vehicle begins to move ... steer as necessary

Gently rock the vehicle by shifting between forward and reverse.

If all else fails – CALL FOR HELP!

Fire Safety Starts With You



Holiday Cooking

- Cooking is the cause of **158,400 home fires** per **year** which also results in **470 deaths** and **4,150 injuries**.
- Do not use the stove or stove top if you are **sleepy** or have **consumed alcohol**.
- **Stay in the kitchen** while you are frying, boiling, grilling, or broiling food.
- If simmering, baking, or roasting food, **check it regularly**, **remain in the home** while food is cooking and use a timer.
- If you have a **small grease cooking fire** and **decide to fight the fire**:
 - On the **stove top**, **smother the flames** by sliding a lid over the pan and turn off the burner. Leave covered until completely cooled.
 - For an **oven fire**, **turn off the heat and keep door closed**.
 - In the event of any fire-small or large, **call the Fire Department**.
- **WHEN IN DOUBT, JUST GET OUT!**

Christmas Tree Fires

- Fire departments responded to an estimated **160 home fires** per **year** caused by the ignition of Christmas Trees.
- Make sure the tree is at least **three feet from any heat source** such as heaters, radiators, candles, or lights.
- Christmas **tree fires are not common**, but **most** Christmas tree fires are **caused by electrical problems**.
- **Replace** any string of lights **with wire or broken cords** or **loose bulb connections**.
- **Never use lit candles** to decorate the tree.
- **Always turn off** Christmas tree **lights** before **leaving home and going to bed**.
- **Add water** to your live trees stand **daily!**



Commanders’ Update: Increasing access to Primary Care Appointments

BDAACH intends to achieve the following goals in the next 2 months:

1. **Acute Care (Urgent):** Within 24-48 hrs
2. **Routine Care (Non-urgent/Follow-up):** Reduce wait time to 14 days

BDAACH Access to Care – Appointment Reminders

Forgetting to go to your appointments? Make sure you're getting Appointment Reminders!

Why should I get Appointment Reminders?

- Patients who elect to receive appointment reminders will be notified in advance of their appointment using a recorded message.
- This message may also be used to share important information, such as inclement weather closures and emergency notifications related to patient appointments.
- Each reminder notifies you of the appointment date, time, provider, clinic and MTF.
- The reminders also provide information on how to cancel the appointment, if necessary.

How to get Appointment Reminders

When checking in for your appointment at the clinic front desk, only need to update two things!

1. Contact Information
2. Notification Preferences

Allergy Patient Immunizations

- Established Allergy Patients can receive continuation of allergy shots. Appointment only, same as above.

Pediatric Immunizations & Well-Child Care

- For well-child exams, child must be empaneled at BDAACH PCMH. To schedule: Call the Central Appointments **DSN: 315-737-CARE (2273) Commercial: 0503-337-2273**
- Routine childhood immunizations are generally performed during well-child exams. Catch up immunizations can be scheduled in the Immunization Clinic once well-child exam has been completed.

- BDAACH PCMH Immunization Clinic is happy to provide appointments for TRICARE Select and Non-enrolled Patients. For billing information, please check with your insurance or the business office.
- Anyone can book an appointment at the Immunizations Clinic, except for well-child immunizations for children who are not empaneled. Well-child immunizations are only available to children with an assigned PCM at BDAACH PCMH.
- For pediatric immunizations it is recommended to establish care with a host-nation PCM and have vaccines provided with a child's physician/clinic.
- If a patient needs immunization records to be added to their MHS GENESIS patient records, please contact the PAD office on the second floor to have them uploaded.



Danger Zone (between 40 - 140 °F) for longer than 2 hours should be thrown out.

LET'S TALK TURKEY

Unsafe handling and under-cooking your holiday bird can cause foodborne illnesses. Here are a few tips from the USDA to keep your Thanksgiving safe and delicious!

Types of turkeys regulated by the USDA:

3 WAYS TO THAW

While frozen, a turkey is safe indefinitely. As soon as it begins to thaw, bacteria that may have been present before freezing will begin to grow again. Here are three ways to safely thaw your bird:

Refrigerator
Safe to do: thaw for 1-2 days in the refrigerator. If a turkey is thawed in the refrigerator, it can be cooked within 3-4 days.

Cold water
Looked good, only after thawing. How to thaw: to keep the turkey safe, change the water every 30 minutes.

Microwave
Cook immediately after thawing.

How to thaw:
Cook immediately after thawing.

COOK

Your bird is not safe until it reaches 165 °F — you cannot tell by the color.

Remember to ensure any stuffing cooked with the bird reaches 165 °F, too.

Use three places to check the temperature:

- Thickest part of breast
- Innermost part of wing
- Innermost part of thigh

Other turkey tips: remove from microwave if cooked in microwave; avoid overcooking; avoid overcooking.

CHILL

Take your time around the dinner table, but refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours!

Safe in fridge: 3-4 days

Safe in freezer: 2-6 months (if properly wrapped)

Leftovers should be consumed within 3-4 days. Do not refreeze.

Do not serve turkey that has been refrozen.

Remember, bacteria that cause foodborne illness can't be seen or tasted!



Pacific West District Areas of Focus







