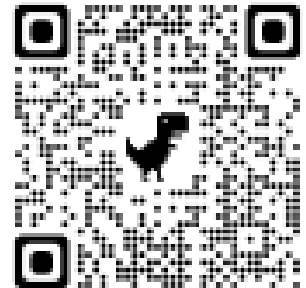

KNP – Right Turn Signal

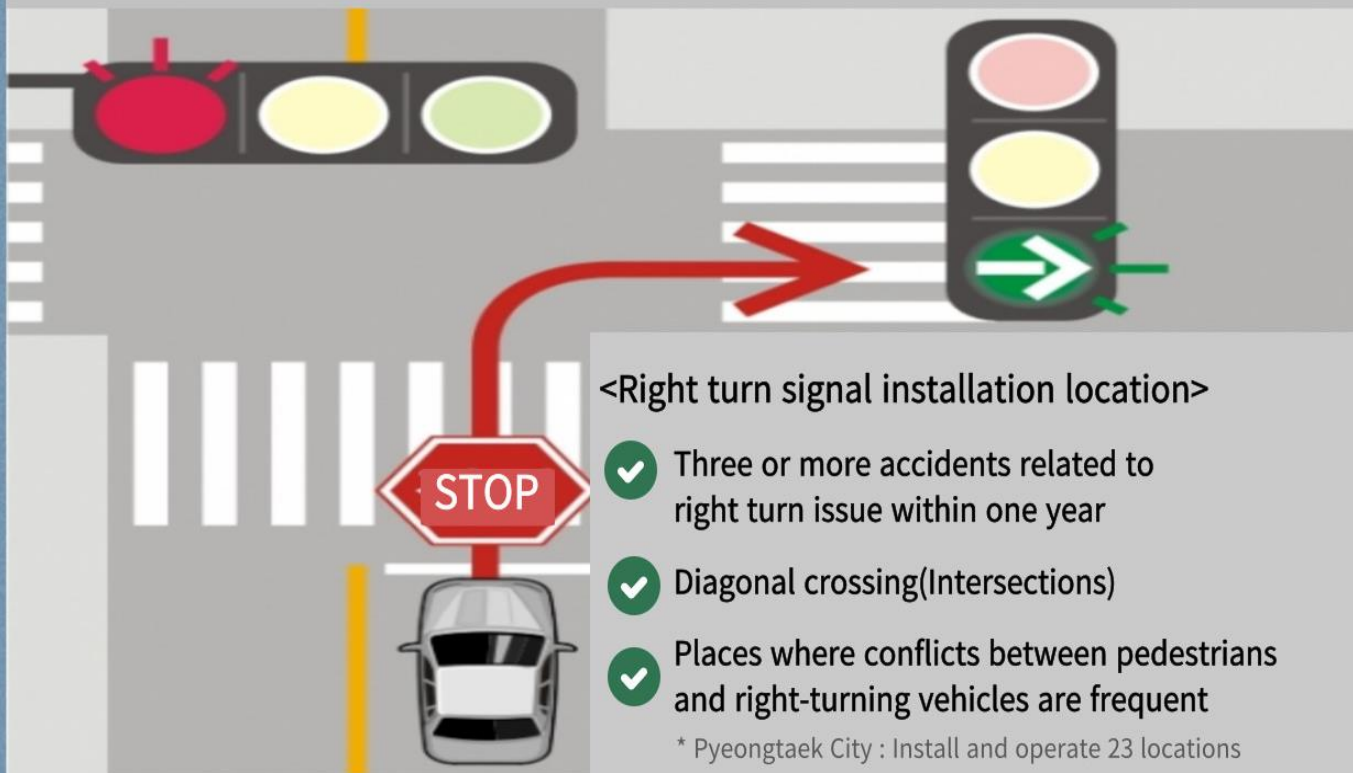


Right Turn Signal for Pedestrian safety (Implemented 22 JAN 2023.)



Driver must follow the right turn signal if a right turn signal is installed.

(*Not installed the right turn signal: Stop temporarily and turn right when the signal is red.)



<Right turn signal installation location>

- ✓ Three or more accidents related to right turn issue within one year
- ✓ Diagonal crossing (Intersections)
- ✓ Places where conflicts between pedestrians and right-turning vehicles are frequent

* Pyeongtaek City : Install and operate 23 locations

★ Right turn signal violation is a same punishment of another traffic signal(fined \$50 and 15 penalty points)

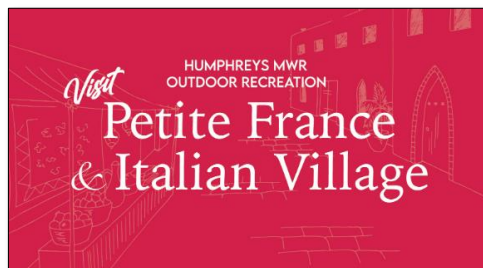

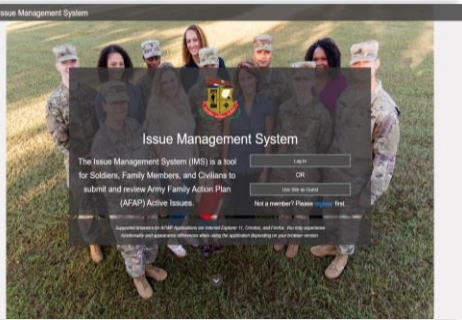

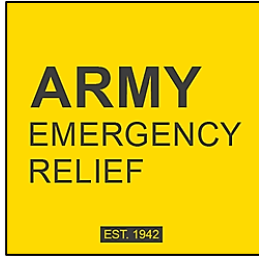
