HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN FLU DRIVE

BEFORE FLU DRIVE

U.S. ARMY

- 1. Find out if you (or your child) are eligible by checking your DEERS record online through the <u>milConnect website</u>.
- 2. Download and fill out DHA 116 Screening Form.
- 3. Download and fill out Flu Vaccine Registration Form.

DURING FLU DRIVE

Each person/child must present 3 items:

- 1. A Government-issued Photo ID
- 2. <u>Pre-filled</u> DHA 116 Screening Form
- 3. <u>Pre-filled</u> Flu Vaccine Registration Form

Those eligible on a reimbursable basis and have OHI (Other Health Insurance) and not TRICARE must ALSO present:

4. Proof of Coverage / Insurance Card

Why get vaccinated?

Influenza vaccine can prevent influenza (flu).

- ANYONE can get the flu. Flu is a contagious disease that spreads every year usually between October and May.
- CDC recommends everyone 6 months and older get vaccinated every flu season. Children 6 months through 8 years of age may need 2 doses during a single flu season. Everyone else needs only 1 dose each flu season.
- There are many flu viruses, and they are always changing. Each year a new flu vaccine is made to protect against the influenza viruses believed to be likely to cause disease in the upcoming flu season. Even when the vaccine doesn't exactly match these viruses, it may still provide some protection.
