Summary: On 16 OCT 2017 the USAG Ansbach RSO held a Red Cross certification for three contractors, two UMT members, and fifteen chapel volunteers. Two Red Cross instructors travelled from Stuttgart and taught two separate three hour sessions for the two different groups. Along with the five hours of online training, 20 RSO members, contractors, and volunteers are now certified in the mandated 8 hour First Aid/CPR/AED as required in AR 165-1 para 5-7.2.d and CYS SOP para 5-2.b.6. dated 31MAY2017. These certifications greatly improve the chapel's readiness in case of a medical emergency and the Garrison Commander's Line of Effort Ready and Resilient.
