

Chaplains Pay Tribute to Fallen Soldiers



SUMMARY: USAG Italy's Chaplain Mark McCorkle joined COL Smallwood and CSM Metcalf of Regional Contracting 414th Contracting Support Brigade for the wreath laying ceremony and prayer to recognize all the Italian Soldiers who gave their lives during war. The Asiago War Memorial is a World War I memorial located in the town of Asiago in the Veneto region of northeast Italy. This area surrounded by mountains was the site of several [World War I](#) battles. The monument houses the remains of over 50,000 Italian and Austro-Hungarian Soldiers. In Italian the memorial is typically called Sacrario Militare di Asiago or Sacrario Militare del Leiten. Leiten is the name of the hill on which the memorial sits.
