Consultation on Religious Education as a Critical Spiritual Readiness Asset

On Tuesday 26 September Garrison Chaplain (LTC) Todd Cheney convened a Religious Support Office (RSO) consultation with IMCOM Directorate-Europe Religious Education Program Director, Dr. Grace Yeuell, to strategize better ways to leverage religious education programs and processes in support of spiritual readiness.

Topics included emerging spiritual readiness priorities such as combatting social isolation and revitalizing community life across the garrison. Discussion of educational ways to respond included developing more relational and experiential opportunities for spiritual growth and development.

This consultation confirmed the need to fully utilize the expertise of the garrison's Director of Religious Education (DRE) and the service of its many Chapel Volunteers to build a spiritually ready Army community.
