Summary: 22 Paratroopers from 4-319 AFAR participated in a Moral Leadership Training Event (MLT) on 18 MAR 24 at Dachau, the former concentration camp, near Munich Germany. CH (MAJ) Heibel coordinated with 1LT Timothy Gerholdt to plan and execute this event for 2nd Platoon, Assassin Battery. This was a single training day event using Building Strong and Ready Teams (BSRT) funds. Transportation and a meal, at the memorial site, was included. **On 15 MAR 24 CH Heibel presented a Holocaust history and ethics brief to the platoon.** The brief gave the historical context of the Holocaust and made connections to ethics, leadership and current challenges. The visit to Dachau was an educational experience for all participants. It offered a sobering consideration of historical evils and the importance of individual character for future leadership. Mr. Robert Auker, the USAG-Bavaria Director of Religious Education (DRE) provided significant logistical support and BSRT management for the planning and execution of the event.
