


**The AST Garmisch Safety Office informs:

**ST 2062 Bad Kohlgrub – Murnau**

**B2 Murnau-Spatzenhausen**



## **HIGHWAY B23, from Garmisch-Partenkirchen towards Austria, between Grainau-Griesen, near the “Oxenhuette”.**

**Accidents in the wintertime are not only caused by the lack of sunshine in the area, they are also caused by the snow from the snowmaking machines from the nearby ski resort.**

**Other accident causes: - Speeding (2003 – 10 accidents – 6 because of speeding)**

## **HIGHWAY B 23, BETWEEN OBERAU - ETTAL**

**Accident causes: - Sliding in dangerous S-curves (because of new asphalt road cover, only 5 accidents in 2003 at the top S-curve)**

## **HIGHWAY B 2, BETWEEN GARMISCH-KALTENBRUNN, CALLED “SCHWABE KURVE” (2003 – 10 accidents)**

**Accident causes:**

- Speeding**
- Black Ice**
- Snow and Ice**

## **HIGHWAY B 2, BETWEEN MURNAU-SPATZENHAUSEN**

**Accident causes:**

- Speeding**

## **STREET 2062, BETWEEN BAD KOHLGRUB – MURNAU ( 1 fatality in 2003)**

**Accident causes:**

- Speeding (now speed limit 70 km for most of the part of the road)**
