Brenda Lee McCullough was selected to the Senior Executive Service in April 2015 and currently serves as the Director of Installation Management Command-Pacific (IMCOM-Pacific). She manages a regional staff that provides oversight of 11 Garrisons located in Alaska, Hawaii, Japan, Korea, and Kwajalein Atoll that support a population of approximately 295,000; and provides oversight of an annual budget exceeding \$1.8 billion as well as over \$6 billion under the Army's Facility Investment Plan. The IMCOM-Pacific area of responsibility includes 12,000 Army-owned and privatized family housing units and over 44,000 Unaccompanied Personnel Housing living spaces.

Previously, Ms. McCullough served as the Director of Installation Management Command-Readiness at Fort Liberty, North Carolina, and managed a team that provides support to a population of approximately 1.4 million, as well as oversight of an annual budget exceeding \$2.9 billion for programs across several appropriations and non-appropriated funds. She also provided oversight of 9.1 million acres of land and 347.4 million square feet of facilities with a replacement value of over \$182 billion and annual contracts totaling in excess of \$1.4 billion.

Prior to this assignment, Ms. McCullough was the Deputy Director for Transformation and Restationing, Headquarters, United States Forces Korea (USFK). In this position she served as a consultant and advisor to USFK leadership, and other DOD agencies and military commands, Host Nation governmental agencies, and engineering and construction firms. She exercised broad discretionary authority in the areas of construction program management, program planning and evaluation, resource planning and utilization, maintenance of external relationships, and technical advisory services.
