

Participation & Eligibility

Soldiers are authorized to participate in one Army Career Skills Program during their last 180 days in the Service. They can participate in one of the three types of CSPs, an **Army Approved CSP**, **DoD Skillbridge Program**, or an **Individual Internship Program**.

The CSP is a Commander's program and a Soldier's participation in a CSP must be approved by the first field grade officer with UCMJ authority in the Soldier's Chain of Command

Before a Soldier can leave for their CSP:

- Soldier must be within 180 days of their separation/retirement date
- Soldier must have completed TAP
 - Attended mandatory classes
 - Submitted CRS/deliverables
 - **Attended Capstone appointment**
- Soldier must have Commander approval
- **Some programs may have additional requirements**

CSP Stats

- The Career Skills Program provides Soldiers the opportunity to participate in skills training, during their transition period, in order to improve their civilian employment options. CSPs are conducted while Soldiers are still on active duty.
- CSP was originally created 14 January 2013 with 16 Soldiers with 14 completing the program and 14 hired into civilian careers after their military service. To date, over 49,965 Soldiers have completed one of the 226 CSPs hosted at 31 IMCOM installations, partnering with over 4,000 employers delivering a 93% hire rate since 2013.

CSPs are also called:

- Apprenticeships
- Internships
- On-the-Job Training (OJT)
- Employment Skills Training
