UA VIP: HVAC/R



Course Description

An 18 week course through the United Association (UA) to prepare Service Members with the skill sets and resources to obtain professional certification as a Heating Ventilation Air Conditioning & Refrigeration (HVAC/R) Service Technician.

Specifics

A service technician's work covers the general responsibilities for heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration (HVAC-R). This would include the installation and maintenance of all sizes of heating and cooling systems for residential, commercial, institutional and industrial applications. Some job specific applications include complete gas piping installations, high voltage electrical components, testing and analyzing and start-up of systems.

Funding: UA International Training Fund; No cost to Soldiers

Placement locations: The United Association has over 300 locals nationwide that support placement for graduates into employment

Eligibility requirements

1. Active Duty transitioning (priority)
2. Secure Command authorization to participate
3. Honorable or General discharge
4. Correctable vision to 20/20.
5. Able to stand for long periods of time and lift 50 lbs.
6. ASVAB Composite Score of 50 or higher. Mechanical Score of 40
