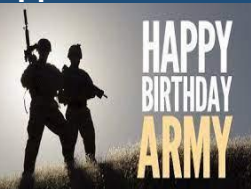

5 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW/DO

- IPPSA: Once notified of your assignment, log in to IPPSA and complete your Member Elections immediately.
- IMCOM Form 78: After the weekly CAP Cycle pull, you will receive an email with the required IMCOM Form 78. Complete and return it to the Reassignments office promptly to process your PCS orders.
- OCONUS Assignments: For all OCONUS assignments, initiate the Command Sponsorship process on the E-EFMP site (<https://efmp.army.mil>) for the medical screening of all dependents.
- PCS Orders: Once you receive your official PCS orders, contact the Transportation and Housing office immediately to arrange your move and avoid unexpected charges.
- Leave & TDY: Coordinate with your S1 for all absence requests. For house hunting, submit the Permissive TDY request before your PCS leave request. The clearance process begins 10 business days before your leave starts.

CONUS/OCOUNUS Travel Pay & Allowances:

TLE – Temporary Lodging Expenses:

- TLE partially offsets the added living expenses within CONUS incurred by a member and dependents incident to a PCS.
- You are authorized up to 21 days of TLE on CONUS to CONUS, and up to 7 days CONUS to OCONUS.

TLA – Temporary Lodging Allowance:

- TLA is intended to partially pay a Service member for higher-than-normal expenses incurred by a member or dependent while occupying temporary lodging OCONUS
- **BAH** continues for the losing duty station rate until the Soldier arrives to their new location.

DLA – Dislocation Allowance:

- To partially reimburse a member, with or without dependents, for the expenses incurred in relocating the members household on a PCS.
- All Soldiers, regardless of rank when accompanied With dependents will receive DLA at the “with dependent” rate.
- Single or unaccompanied SSG or above will receive DLA at the “without dependent” rate.

Mileage and Transportation Allowance: Covers the cost of gas for Soldier and their dependents for mileage reimbursement. Reimbursement for two vehicles as of 01 January 2026:

- One vehicle - \$0.205 a mile
- Two vehicles - \$0.41 a mile

Per diem: To assist with payment of lodging and meals for Soldiers and dependents while enroute
Per diem rate when driving POV as of 1 Oct 2022:

Soldier	\$178.00 per day
Dependents 12 and over	\$133.50 per day
Dependents under 12	\$ 89.00 per day

Per diem rate when flying:

\$51.00 for one day of travel for Soldiers
\$38.25 for one day of travel for dependents over the age of 12
\$25.50 for one day of travel for dependents under the age of 12

Pet Expenses Due to PCS:

- A service member on a PCS order may be authorized reimbursement for the costs related to the relocation of one household pet that arises from a PCS.
- Household pet is a cat or dog, CONUS PCS- Up to \$550, OCONUS PCS- Up to \$2000.
- Reimbursable expenses includes Mandatory microchipping, Boarding Fees, Hotel service charges, Licensing fees, Pet shipping fees, Quarantine Fees.

Process Personally Procured Moves (PPM)

- After creating your account on <https://militaryonesource.mil> you will be asked if this will be a PPM, answer “Yes” and complete application.
- Counselors can assist with uploading documents.
- You will receive confirmation that your request for PPM has been accepted.
- Directions to post weigh scales (pre-move weight tickets) are available at PPPO Bldg.105.
- Once request has been submitted you are required to go to the PPPO for completion of the Household Goods shipment to be submitted for processing.

NOTICE TO VACATE

This is where your Leasing Specialist will go over all the paperwork and details for your move out. Bring Orders if 30 days out or less.

03

PRE INSPECTION

Your Leasing Specialist will come to the home and discuss potential costs and cleaning options.

04

BULK TRASH

Schedule bulk trash pick-up **before** the final move out date.

05

MOVE OUT FINALIZED

Everything must be out of the home for the final move out. Trash must also be gone.

06

CLEARING

To get clearing papers signed by us, you must have **completed** your final move out process.

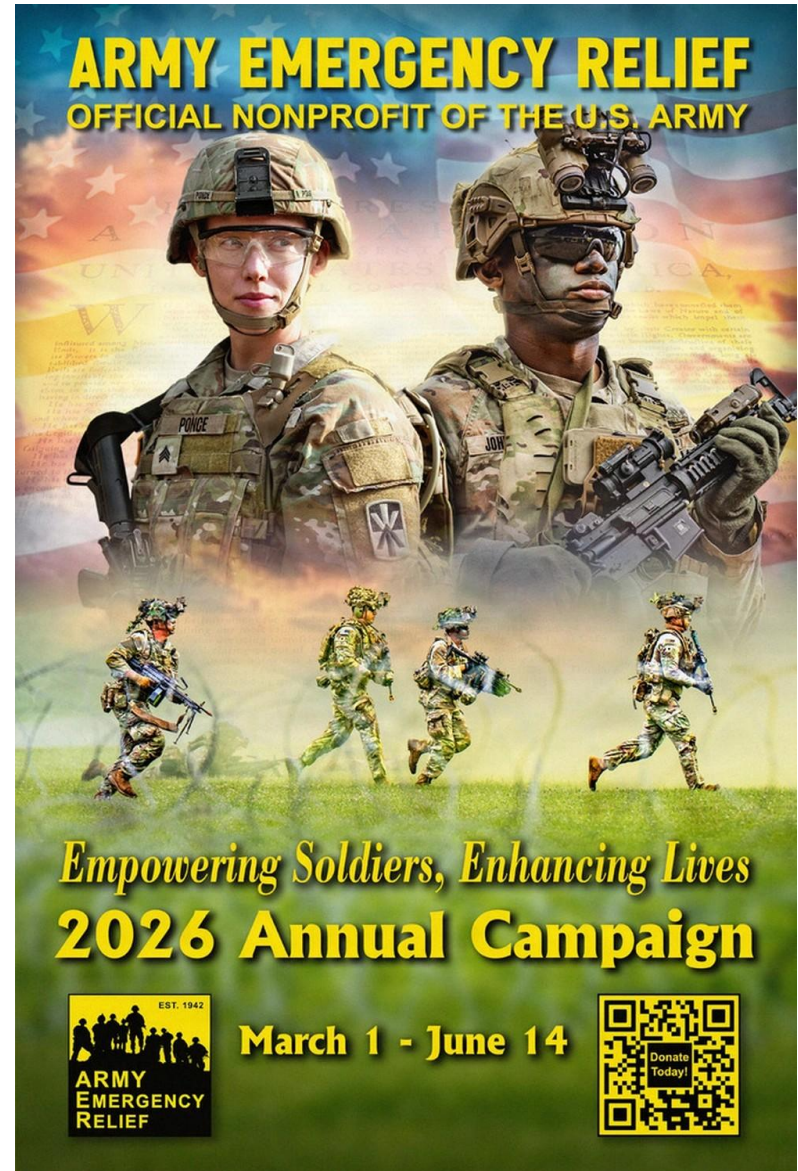

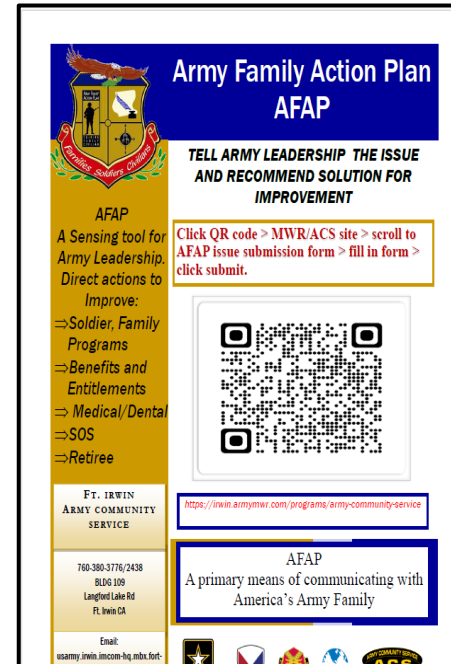
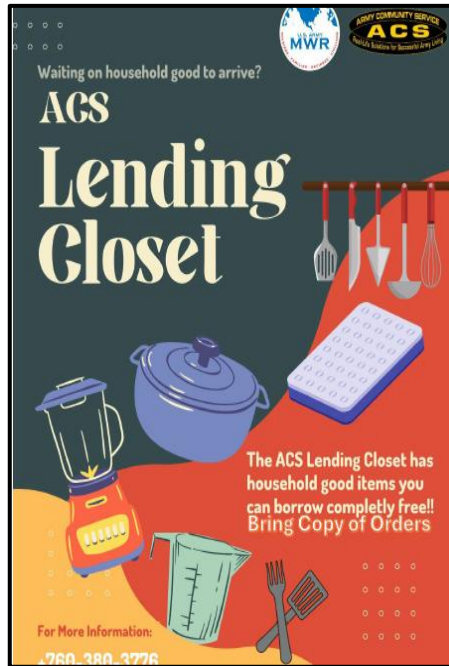
