

Who is eligible to participate?

1. All Army Active Component (AC) military service members.
2. Army Reserve Component (RC) military service members (Army Reserve and Army National Guard) who are currently on active duty.
3. DoD/DA Federal civilian employees, including part-time federal employees and interns.
4. DA Non-Appropriated Fund (NAF) personnel employed by a duly constituted Army Non-Appropriated Funded Instrumentality (NAFI) under the control of the Secretary of the Army and organized under the provision of AR 215-1 (Military Morale, Welfare, And Recreation Programs And Non-Appropriated Fund Instrumentalities), (e.g., NAFI activities managed by the U.S. Army Family and Morale Welfare and Recreation Command).

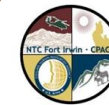

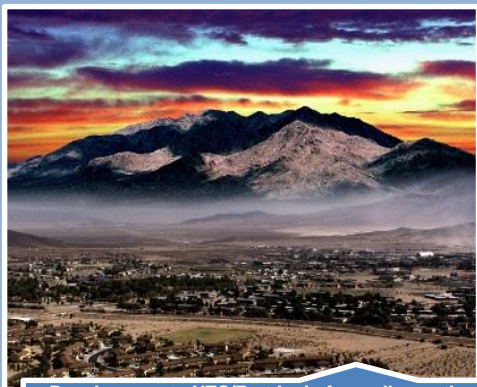

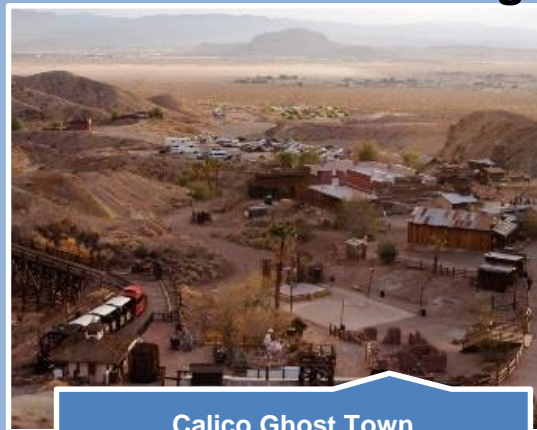

Attractions/Things to Do in the Fort Irwin Area



People come to NTC/Fort Irwin from all over the world to hike the Tietfort Mountains, which are located directly on the installation in the [Mojave Desert of San Bernardino County](#).

It is approximately 12 miles long and peaks at 5,063 feet high as one of California's highest mountains.

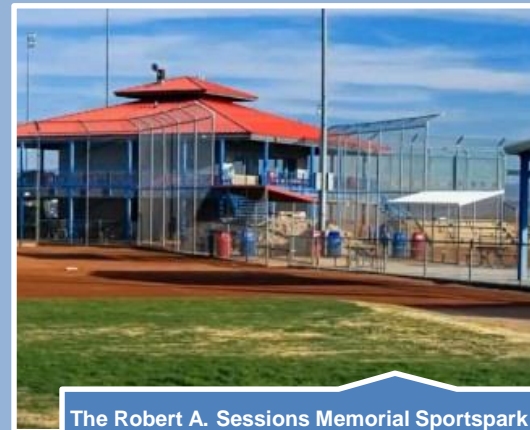

Located just an hour and 15 minutes from Fort Irwin alongside an old riverbed in the High Desert south of Victorville, Mojave Narrows Regional Park offers acres of waterways, wildlife and meadows. In addition, there is year-round fishing, disc golf course, equestrian trails, a playground, climbing rocks, splash pad and hiking trails.



The Robert A. Sessions Memorial Sports Park includes six ball fields, three soccer fields, volleyball courts, batting cages, and basketball courts. This recreational complex is located 30 minutes from Fort Irwin.



Rainbow Basin Natural Area with outstanding views and geological and paleontological features. Many visitors come to see exciting multi-colored rock formations and walk the scenic canyons. A variety of fossils and desert-adapted wildlife are found here, including the desert tortoise. (30 minutes from NTC)



Dumont Dunes Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area consists of big bowls, steep climbs and a variety of other terrain for OHV sand dune enthusiasts. There's also camping, fabulous scenery, and opportunities for solitude. (2 hours from NTC)



Mitchell's Caverns are a trio of limestone caves, located in the Providence Mountains State Recreation Area in Southern California. There, caves are connected by a man-made tunnel and are open to guided tours. (2.5 hours from NTC)



The Bureau of Land Management in the Barstow area offers hunting, fishing, recreating shooting, mountain biking, climbing, and national scenic/historic trails. (40 minutes from NTC)

Nearly a dozen golf courses located within 2 hours.

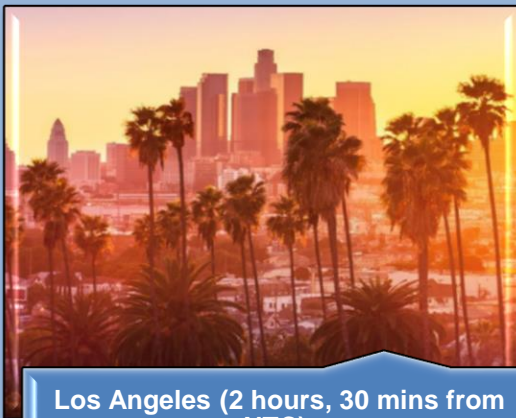
