The provided spot bids shall be used to determine best value for the management and sale of these commodities for the period of <u>30 days</u> starting <u>29</u> <u>March 2022</u>. All submitted and valid bids shall be published. Your submission of bid in no way commits Fort Irwin to using your services. Submission of spot bid prices in response to this solicitation and acceptance of materials from the Fort Irwin Recycle Center during the period covered by the bid shall constitute a sales agreement subject to the terms of this solicitation and the prices bid.
- Inspection Period: Prospective bidders shall be able to visit Fort Irwin and observe the condition of the recyclable material during the period of 22-25 February 2022 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM. Viewing time is estimated to be 30-45 minutes. Pictures of the material will be provided upon request to the above emails.
- 3. <u>Bid Instructions:</u> All bids must be submitted by <u>4 March 2022</u>. Late bids will not be considered. Bid only on commodities you are capable of recycling. Place your bid price (per pound) in the "Per Pound Price Offer" column next to the items you wish to purchase. For items you do not wish to purchase (are not bidding on) place an "N/A" in the "Per Pound Price Offer" column next to the item. For each item bid include the period of time to clear the material off of the installation. Fort Irwin expects the material to be cleared in 30 days. The bid must also include a signed letter on your company's letterhead. The letter shall include the statement indicating that the enclosed bid is your offer and the period your offer is valid if greater than 30 days from 21 March 2022.

The winning bidder is responsible for providing all personnel, equipment, supplies, facilities, transportation, tools, materials, supervision, other items and non-personal services necessary to perform, collect, and transport recyclable commodities from the Fort Irwin Installation Recycle Center, Building 684, Sanitary Landfill Road, Fort Irwin, California, 92310.
- 6. All recyclable material leaving Fort Irwin shall be weighed on Fort Irwin. The scales are located at the Fort Irwin Landfill. Weights used for the sales shall be either the Fort Irwin scales (certified in California) or a certified scale.
