Fort Irwin Soldier Arrested for Possession of Child Pornography

FORT IRWIN, Calif. — A U.S. Army Soldier was arrested and booked into the High Desert Detention Center for possession of child pornography. Sgt. Sean Patrick Barlow II, 33, an infantryman with 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment, was arrested by San Bernardino County Sheriff Department on Tuesday, Sept. 6, 2022. He entered the U.S. Army on Nov. 4, 2013 and arrived at Fort Irwin July 22, 2019.

"We take this matter very seriously," said Brig. Gen. Curtis D. Taylor, commander, National Training Center and Fort Irwin. "We have a strong relationship and are cooperating fully with local law enforcement to ensure the continued safety and welfare of all within our community."
