

# Creazzo – Zone 1 - Refuse Collection

## DRY WASTE (SECCO) - (NON-ROTTING TYPE) – (NOT RECYCLABLE ITEMS)

- Various types of plastic (excluding liquid containers)
- Rubber and Styrofoam, Non recyclable paper
- Audio/video cassettes/CDs and relative containers
- Nylon film, bags, cellophane
- Plastic plates and cutlery
- Buckets, basins and toys
- Pens and small plastic Bakelite objects
- Carbon paper, oily/laminated paper
- Nylons, Non recyclable rags, Band aid, Cloth
- Painted wooden objects, coat hangers, bags
- Small pieces of broken ceramic or porcelain
- Diapers, sanitary towels, cosmetics
- Dust from vacuum cleaners
- Old shoes, Light bulbs, Cigarette butts

### WHERE TO PUT THEM:

Collect them in **transparent or semi-transparent plastic Yellow bags only** (*You'll find them in stores*) to be put on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup.

**Pick up is every week on THURSDAY.**

**Take Note! Place only waste that has no other disposal designation.** (See the list above)

## RECYCLABLE ITEMS

### HUMID WASTE (UMIDO) - (ORGANIC – ROTTING TYPE)

- Bad food, Egg shells
- Vegetable and fruit peelings
- Coffee grounds and tea bags
- Cat litter and animal excrement
- Cut flowers and house plants
- Stale bread
- Paper tissues and dirty napkins
- Cold fireplace ashes
- Small bones and seafood shells (clams, mussels)



**NO: Diapers, rags, other type of recyclable items, dangerous items.**

The humid waste must be collected in **mater-bi (biodegradable) bags** that will be closed and placed in the proper **BUCKET (Yellow or Green - given by the Municipality)**. Then the bucket will be put on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the pickup. (**REMEMBER to take it back**).

**Pick up is on TUESDAY, THURSDAY and SATURDAY in all Comune areas.**

**SCHEDULE VARIATION: No Pick Up on: Tuesday January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019**

**PUT ONLY THE ITEMS LISTED ABOVE AND NO OTHERS !!**

## **PLASTIC AND CANS:**

- Plastic bottles (up to 5 lt.- pressed & closed), shopping bags, gardening vases
- Cans: aluminum (drinks), tuna & meat, vegetables & other foods
- Throwaway food containers (also in polystyrene material)



All items, once cleaned and washed, will be put in a **transparent or semitransparent blue plastic bags (NO black bags)** that will be put on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup.

**Squeeze and reduce bottles. - Pick up is every two weeks on WEDNESDAY** (alternated with PAPER - **See SCHEDULE**)

**SCHEDULE VARIATION:** *December 25<sup>th</sup> → Sunday, December 29<sup>th</sup>*

## **GLASS (VETRO):**

- Bottles, glasses, glass vases, crystal (do not include metal or plastic cover)

**NO:** Ceramics, porcelains, light bulb or neon tubes.

Glass has to be put **CLEAN, without caps and tops** in the **proper container** given by municipality and put out in the street the evening before the day of pickup. Plastic parts go with 'Plastic Items' Container must be close – don't fill it too much.

**Pick up is every two weeks on MONDAY** ( **See SCHEDULE**)

**In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.**



## **PAPER AND CARDBOARD (CARTA):**

- Newspapers, magazines, books, workbooks, papers (without plastic parts)
- Folded cardboards, cardboard boxes
- Tetra pack (milk, juice: empty, clean and squeezed)
- Food paper (without plastic parts)



**NO:** Plasticized papers, oily papers, carbon papers, chemical papers.

Papers and cardboard must be packed and tied or placed in cardboard boxes to be thrown away and must be placed on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup. (Packages should not exceed 15 kilos each). **DON'T USE PLASTIC BAGS**

**Pick up is every two weeks on WEDNESDAY** (alternated with PLASTIC – **See SCHEDULE**)

**SCHEDULE VARIATION:** *December 25<sup>th</sup> → anticipated to December 22<sup>nd</sup>;*

## **WHAT TO BRING TO ECOCENTRO:**

- GREEN & BRANCHES: Branches, leaves, plants (without ground), vegetal residues
- WOOD: Wooden parts only from: constructions, furniture, packing.
- OILS: Vegetable oils (cooking)
- RAEE: Wastes from electric/electronic house equipments or appliances
- R.U.P. Dangerous refuses, batteries, car batteries, expired medicines
- Bulky RSI Mattresses, mirrors, various bulky packages, sofa, easy chairs, etc.
- DURABLE GOODS: Refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, TV, computers, printers.
- OTHERS: Old shoes, clothing, car tires, glass, iron.
- LABELED "T" & "F" Glues, sprays, insecticides, acids, solvents, etc.

Products that have this symbol on the container  
be taken to the ECOCENTRO.
