MEMORANDUM FOR All U.S. Army Garrison (USAG) Italy Units and Supported Units SUBJECT: USAG Italy Policy for Designating Housing to Key and Essential Personnel

## 1. Reference:

- a. Army Regulation (AR) 420-1, dated 02 Feb. 2008
- b. Army Europe Regulation (AER) Supplement 1 to 420-1, 20 Nov. 2008
- 2. This memorandum supersedes all previous USAG Italy Memorandums for Key and Essential Positions and Designated Housing at USAG Italy.
- 3. IAW AR 420-1 and AER Supplement 1 to AR 420-1, the Installation Commander may designate Key and Essential positions. The Housing Office maintains a list of Key and Essential positions for housing units and makes assignments to quarters as indicated below for accompanied personnel.
- 4. The following are Key and Essential personnel with "designated" housing by position:

SETAF-AF Commander General SETAF-AF Deputy Commander General SETAF-AF Chief of Staff SETAF-AF Command Sergeant Major 173<sup>rd</sup> Airborne Brigade, Commander USAG Italy Commander

- 5. Key and Essential personnel are eligible for assignment to government quarters on a priority "1" basis. Furthermore, the positions listed in enclosure 1, in the grade of Lieutenant Colonel (O-5) and above, CSM (E-9) or GS-14 and above are eligible for assignment, on a priority "1" basis. Assignment to these units is contingent on availability and allocated on a basis of five (5) for Field Grade/Senior Officers and three (3) Command Sergeant Major where possible.
- 6. Positions listed above will be given priority "1" assignment at available Government Controlled Quarters of the appropriate category or given priority assistance in obtaining private rental housing.
- 7. Once housed in either Government Controlled Quarters or private rental housing personnel will be removed from the respective waiting list and will not normally be reinstated unless an exception is approved by the USAG Italy Commander.

- 8. In addition to personnel occupying the above positions, also Officers and Command Sergeant Major pre-positioned to fill one of these positions are considered Key and Essential for assignment purpose.
- 9. Red Cross Hub and Station Manager are designated Key and Essential Civilian positions for assignment to Government Leased Quarters only on a priority "1" basis.
- 10. Sponsors losing their Key and Essential status due to change in job assignment also lose their entitlement to Key and Essential housing. This memorandum includes sponsors who receive priority assignment to Key and Essential housing and sponsors may be required to relocate from housing. Upon loss of Key and Essential status, sponsors may be required to relocate from Government Controlled Quarters at the discretion of the USAG Italy Commander. In the event a command directed move becomes necessary, moving expenses will be government funded.
- 11. Request for exception to policy to reside in private rental housing will be forwarded through DPW, Housing Office to the USAG Italy Commander for approval.
