

# Grumolo - Refuse Collection

## DRY WASTE (SECCO) - (NON-ROTTING TYPE) – (NOT RECYCLABLE ITEMS)

- Various types of plastic (excluding liquid containers)
- Rubber and Styrofoam, Non recyclable paper
- Audio/video cassettes/CDs and relative package
- Nylon film, bags, cellophane
- Plastic plates and cutlery
- Buckets, basins and toys
- Pens and small plastic Bakelite objects
- Carbon paper, oily/laminated paper
- Nylons, Non recyclable rags, Band aid, Cloth
- Small pieces of broken ceramic or not painted wood
- Diapers, sanitary towels, cosmetics
- Dust from vacuum cleaners
- Old shoes, Light bulbs, Cigarette butts



### WHERE TO PUT THEM:

Collect them in **transparent plastic bags** that will be put in the **GREEN BIN** (given by the Municipality), and when the bin is FULL, put it on the public street, in front of your dwelling unit the evening before the day of pickup.

**Pick up is every two weeks on FRIDAY – (See SCHEDULE).**

**Take Note!** Place only waste that has no other disposal designation. (See the list above)

## RECYCLABLE ITEMS

### HUMID WASTE (UMIDO) - (ORGANIC – ROTTING TYPE)

- Bad food, Egg shells
- Vegetable and fruit peelings
- Coffee grounds and tea bags
- Cat litter and animal excrement
- Cut flowers and house plants
- Stale bread
- Paper tissues and dirty napkins
- Cold fireplace ashes
- Small bones and seafood shells (clams, mussels)
- Small pieces of wood (not painted)



Humid waste must be collected in **mater-bi (biodegradable) bags** that will be closed and placed in the **locked BROWN BIN** you will find located nearby your house (key given by the Municipality).

**PUT IN THE CONTAINER ONLY THE ITEMS LISTED ABOVE AND NO OTHERS !!**

## **PLASTIC AND CANS:**

- Plastic bottles. Plastic bags. Plastic vases.
- Cans: aluminum (drinks), tuna & meat, vegetables & other foods
- Throwaway food containers. Styrofoam



All the items, once cleaned and washed, must be collected in **transparent plastic bags only**, **labelled Soraris (See in last page where you can buy them)** and must be put out on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup. **Squeeze and reduce bottles. Pick up is every three weeks on SATURDAY – (See SCHEDULE).**  
In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.

## **GLASS (VETRO):**

- Bottles, glass, glass vases

**NO:** Ceramics, porcelains, light bulb or neon tubes, mirrors.

All the above items must be collected in the **white bucket** (given by the Municipality) that must be put out, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup.

**Pick up is every three weeks on SATURDAY – (See SCHEDULE).**

In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.



## **PAPER AND CARDBOARD (CARTA):**

- Newspapers, magazines, books, workbooks, papers (without plastic parts)
- Folded cardboards, cardboard boxes
- Tetra pack (without plastic parts)

**NO:** Plasticized papers, oily/plasticized papers, carbon papers, chemical paper.

Papers and cardboard must be packed and tied or placed in cardboard boxes to be thrown away. It must be put out on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup. **DON'T USE PLASTIC BAGS**

**Pick up is every three weeks on SATURDAY – (See SCHEDULE).**

In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.



## **WHAT TO BRING TO ECOCENTRO:**

|---------------------|------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| • GREEN & BRANCHES: | Branches, leaves, plants (without ground), vegetal residues                        |
| • WOOD:             | Wooden parts only from: constructions, furniture, packing.                         |
| • MATERIALS ...     | Materials from small demolitions. Used cloths and textiles.                        |
| • OILS:             | Vegetal oils (cooking), mineral oils (engine lubricants) – In separated containers |
| • RAEE:             | Wastes from electric/electronic house equipments or appliances                     |
| • R.U.P.            | Dangerous refuses, batteries, car batteries, expired medicinal                     |
| • Bulky RSI         | Mattresses, mirrors, various bulky packages, sofa, easy chairs, etc.               |
| • DURABLE GOODS:    | Refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, TV, computers, printers.                      |

Small batteries and expired medicinal can also be put in the **PROPER CONTAINERS** in the area.

Products that have this symbol on the container be taken to the ECOCENTRO.
