Montegalda - Refuse Collection

SOLID WASTE (SECCO) - (NON-ROTTING TYPE) - (NOT RECYCLABLE ITEMS)

- Various types of plastic (excluding liquid containers)
- Rubber and Styrofoam, Non recyclable paper
- Audio/video cassettes/CDs and relative containers
- Nylon film, bags, cellophane
- Plastic plates and cutlery
- Buckets, basins and toys
- Pens and small plastic Bakelite objects
- Carbon paper, oily/plasticized paper
- Nylons, Non recyclable rags, Band aid, Cloth
- Small pieces of broken ceramic
- Diapers, sanitary towels, Make-up, cosmetics
- Dust from vacuum cleaners
- Old shoes, Light bulbs, Cigarette butts



GREEN

WHERE TO PUT THEM:

Collect them in **plastic bags** to be put in the **GREEN BIN** (given by the Municipality), and <u>when it's FULL</u>, put it on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of the pickup. The bin has a microchip to count each emptying to be charged. That's why must be <u>emptied when full.</u>

Pick up is every two weeks on TUESDAY alternated in two different Areas (Zone A & B) See the PICK UP SCHEDULE and ZONE in last page.

SCHEDULE VARIATION: Zone A: Tuesday, Jan 1st, 2019 → Wednesday, Jan 2nd;

Place only waste that has no other disposal designation. (See the list above)

RECYCLABLE ITEMS

HUMID WASTE (UMIDO) - (ORGANIC - ROTTING TYPE)

- Bad food, Egg shells
- Vegetable and fruit peelings
- Coffee grounds and tea bags
- Cat litter and animal excrement
- Flowers and house plants
- Stale bread
- Paper tissues and dirty napkins
- Cold fireplace ashes
- Small bones and seafood shells (clams, mussels)



The humid waste must be collected in <u>mater-bi</u> (biodegradable) bags that will be closed and placed in the locked BROWN BIN you will find located in your neighborhood (key is given by the Municipality).

PUT IN THE CONTAINER ONLY THE ITEMS LISTED ABOVE AND NOT OTHERS!!

PLASTIC AND CANS:

- Plastic bottles
- Cans: aluminum (drinks), tuna & meat, vegetables & other foods
- Throwaway food containers

All the items, cleaned and washed, must be collected in **specific labelled SORARIS bags only.**

Squeeze and reduce bottles. - See where to buy them on last page

The bags will be put out on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup.

Pick up is every three weeks on FRIDAY – (Alternate with Paper & Glass - See SCHEDULE) In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.

GLASS (VETRO):

• Bottles, glasses, glass vases

NO: Ceramics, porcelains, light bulb or neon tubes.

All the above items must be cleaned and collected in the **white bucket** (given by the Municipality), that must be put out on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup.

Pick up is every three weeks on FRIDAY – (Alternate with Paper & Plastic - <u>See SCHEDULE</u>) In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.

PAPER AND CARDBOARD (CARTA):

- Newspapers, magazines, books, workbooks, papers (without plastic parts)
- Folded cardboards, cardboard boxes
- Tetra pack (without plastic parts)

NO: Plasticized papers, oily/plasticized papers, carbon papers, chemical paper.

Papers and cardboard must be packed and tied or placed in cardboard boxes to be thrown away. It will be put out on the public street, nearby your dwelling unit, the evening before the day of pickup.

DON'T USE PLASTIC BAGS

Pick up is every three weeks on FRIDAY – (Alternate with Glass & Plastic - <u>See SCHEDULE</u>) In case of need it can be taken to the ECOCENTRO.

WHAT TO BRING TO ECOCENTRO:



GREEN & BRANCHES: Branches, leaves, plants (without ground), vegetal residues
 WOOD: Wooden parts only from: constructions, furniture, packing.

MATERIALS ... Materials from small demolitions

• OILS: Vegetal oils (cooking), mineral oils (engine lubricants) – In separated containers

RAEE: Wastes from electric/electronic house equipments or appliances
 R.U.P. Dangerous refuses, batteries, car batteries, expired medicinal
 Bulky RSI Mattresses, mirrors, various bulky packages, sofa, easy chairs, etc.
 DURABLE GOODS: Refrigerators, dishwashers, washers, TV, computers, printers.

Small batteries and expired medicinal can also be put in the **PROPER CONTAINERS** in the area.





Products that have this symbol on the container be taken to the ECOCENTRO.
