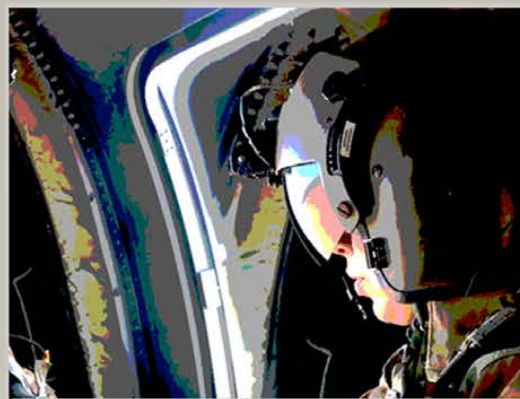
### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

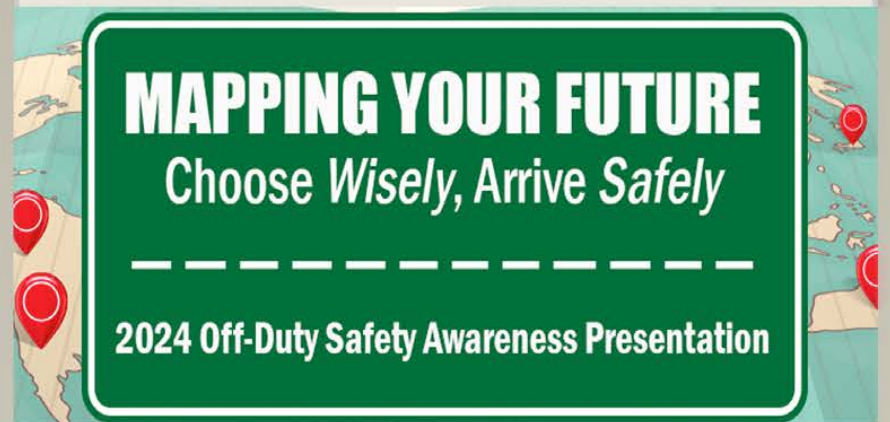
