  - Continue to seek for opportunities for the FJRC to assist the military community

## 4. Garrison Update (COL Tim Hickman)

- CSM Kotula on board since March.
- FJSC 4<sup>th</sup> of July activities had 35k in attendance.
- Victory Hall (formerly known as the O'Club) to reopen this fall as an event center.
- Renovations to Pickens CDC still underway; reopening tenative Spring 2025. Middle School Programs relocated to Solomon Center.
- Renovations to Coleman Gym to begin by Jan 2025.
- Will host a Job Fair/Summit tentatively in September to see if there are business opportunities with the community.

#### 5. Retirement Services Officer Update

- Retiree Appreciation Days (RAD) 16-18 May 2024 AAR conducted with council (See attached), of note:
  - Will improve messaging to partners
  - Provide marked parking spaces for vendors and attendees away from Solomon allowing retirees access to closest spots.
  - Will move buses to another parking lot to provide more retiree parking.
  - The SC National Guard J1.1 and the 81<sup>st</sup> Readiness Division need to be present at the Expo.
  - Will work harder and earlier to advertise with other Services around that state.
  - Next year speaker will be enlisted; need suggestions by September meeting
  - Next year's dates are May 1-3, 2025.

- Several VISN 7 site visits to review telehealth, Community Care, AWE, GEMS,
   SPH, Emergency mgt and engineering programs

### Construction Update

- Bldg. 10 construction delayed for fire suppression pump and exterior porches, expect completed Dec 2024
- Rehabilitation bldg. complete, should be moving into Jun 24

- 2<sup>nd</sup> parking garage construction has started, existing garage has added an additional deck and 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> level is now open. Once complete overall net gain 500 spots
- Parking & Paving project awarded to pave and paint all parking lots on campus as well as install "parking pucks" that will link to an app to show which spots are vacant or full
- New MRI machine being installed in our MRI bldg. Currently, we have a mobile
   MRI unit while the construction is being completed on the new unit

# O Community Based Outpatient Clinic (CBOC) Update

- Sumter new 25K sq ft facility, opened Monday 6 Nov 2023
- Florence construction underway, expected completion Aug 24
- Rock Hill construction underway expected completion fall 24
- Approved for new 285K sq ft HCC in Greenville for design 2025
- Approved for new 55K sq ft clinic in Spartanburg for design 2025
- Requested new clinics for W. Columbia and Laurens County

- o 1 pair of prescription eyeglasses per year authorized for retirees
- o Issue raised about TRICARE For Life (TFL) not having access to MHS Genesis once the service member reaches the age of 65 and is enrolled in Medicare where TFL becomes the secondary insurance. (See attached flyers for assistance)
