Army Programs INSTALLATION POPULATION PROFILE/STRENGTH AND STATISTICAL REPORT

1. PURPOSE. This regulation establishes and prescribes the format and data sources for preparing the Installation Population Profile and Installation Annual Statistical Report.

2. PROCEDURES.

a. The Garrison Directorate of Resource Management (DRM) is responsible for collection and publication of Installation Population Profile. The Plans, Analysis and Integration Office (PAIO) is responsible for collection and publication of the Installation Statistical Report. The Installation Population Profile will be reported monthly. The Installation Annual Statistical Report is published at the end of each fiscal year.

b. To compile data for publication, input is required from organizations specified in the appendices to this regulation. Format for submission of the data is shown in Appendix A, Installation Population Profile and Appendix B Installation Annual Statistical Report. These reports are used by installation organizations to brief strength numbers to the Command Group and others, assist in aligning funded civilian workyears, and prepare various presentations, surveys and studies. Activity managers plan programs and special projects based on numbers of individuals in a particular target market. Reports are also used by activities for trends analyses and as feeder information for input to various reports required by higher headquarters.

c. Input for the Installation Population Profile, Appendix A, (actual civilian and military assigned as of the last work day of the month) will be reported to DRM-Garrison, Manpower, IMSE-JAC-RMM, not later than the 5th workday after the end of each month. Data will be accepted by memorandum or email.

d. Input for Installation Annual Statistical Report, Appendix B will be reported to PAIO no

later than 25 calendar days after the end of the fiscal year. Data will be accepted by memorandum or email (jim.pettus@us.army.mil).
