SUBJECT: Fort Jackson Policy Memorandum #11 - Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board

1. Reference Army Regulation (AR) 190-24 (Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installation Liaison and Operations).

2. Purpose: Establishment of the Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB).

3. Policy:

a. The AFDCB is comprised of the following members or designated representatives:

Garrison Commander - AFDCB President ATC Deputy Commanding Officer **Garrison Command Sergeant Major** Staff Judge Advocate - Legal Advisor **Provost Marshal** U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Division Installation Safety Manager **Public Affairs Officer** Garrison Chaplain **Community Relations Officer Community Health Officer** Alcohol/Drug Control Officer Equal Opportunity Officer **Protection Program Manager** Installation Fire Chief **Director, Emergency Services** Inspector General ATC Force Protection Officer Recorder (Installation Hearing Officer) appointed by AFDCB President AMIM-FJL (190-24a1) SUBJECT: Policy Memorandum #11 - Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board

b. Voting members are expected to exercise their expertise and unbiased judgment and must not be influenced by rank or the rating chain of any other voting members. A majority of voting members will represent a quorum.

c. The ATC deputy commanding officer assumes the duties of the president in his/her absence.

d. Mission commanders and their representatives are encouraged to participate in all AFDCB quarterly meetings.

e. AFDCB outputs will be in accordance with AR 190-24 and include making recommendations to commanders concerning procedures for establishment of off limit areas outside of the installation.

4. This policy memorandum supersedes Policy Memorandum #11, dated 6 July 2018.
