At the start of the school year, one of Charlotte Patterson’s peers gave her a compliment on her being a leader that the high school senior said made her week.



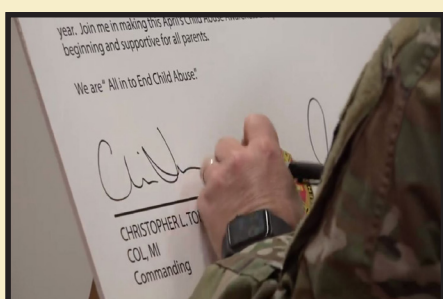
Camp Zama community members get crafty making traditional Japanese kites Army recruiting
