MEMORANDUM FOR Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall Visitors, Residents, and Tenant Organizations.

SUBJECT: Joint Base Myer Henderson Hall (JBM-HH) Temporary Policy Memorandum #2, Cloth Face Coverings

1. REFERENCES.

- a. Secretary of Defense Memorandum, Subject: Department of Defense Guidance on the Use of Cloth Face Coverings, 5 Apr 20.
- b. FRAGO 20 to HQDA EXORD 144-20 Army Wide Preparedness and Response to Coronavirus (COVID-19) Outbreak, 7 Apr 20.
- c. Commanding General, Military District of Washington Memorandum, Subject: COVID-19 Face Covering Guidance to Garrison Commanders, 8 Apr 20.

2. PURPOSE. This is a revision of the 17 Apr 20 JBM-HH policy of the same name. The JBM-HH community is committed to preserving the health and well-being of every individual and will take all prudent actions to mitigate the potential transmission of COVID-19. These actions will be in careful consideration of all Center for Disease Control and DOD guidelines regarding the use of face coverings and social distancing in public spaces.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all individuals visiting public spaces on JBM-HH. Public spaces is defined in paragraph 4 below.

4. POLICY. Effective immediately, all individuals on JBM-HH will wear a cloth face covering when in a public environment where 6 feet physical distancing cannot be maintained. A cloth face covering is required at all times, regardless of physical distancing, in high traffic public facilities on JBM-HH. This includes AAFES Facilities, Marine Corps Base Exchange, the Child Development Center, Old Post Chapel, Memorial Chapel, ID Card Facility and the Commissary.

a. The requirement to wear a cloth face covering shall be clearly posted at the entrance of all high traffic areas by the service provider.
