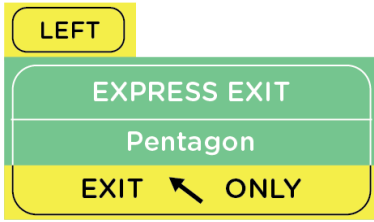


Check out the new 395 Express Lanes

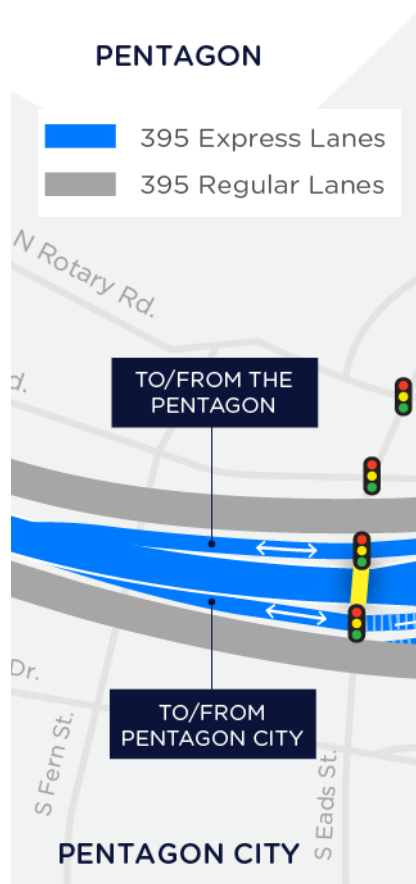


NORTHBOUND in the AM

When traveling northbound, there will be two dedicated exit ramps to S. Eads Street - the left ramp will exit to the Pentagon and the ramp on the right will head toward Pentagon City.

To get to the Pentagon from the northbound 395 Express Lanes, drivers should stay to the left. Signs will point to the Pentagon exit on the left, starting about half a mile before the exit ramp. The left lane will turn into the exit ramp to get to the Pentagon.

Once you take the Pentagon exit ramp, the single lane will split into two. Buses visiting the Pentagon South parking lot should get in the right lane. All other drivers, including carpoolers, should get in the left lane. For the trip home on the southbound Express Lanes, use the same ramp.

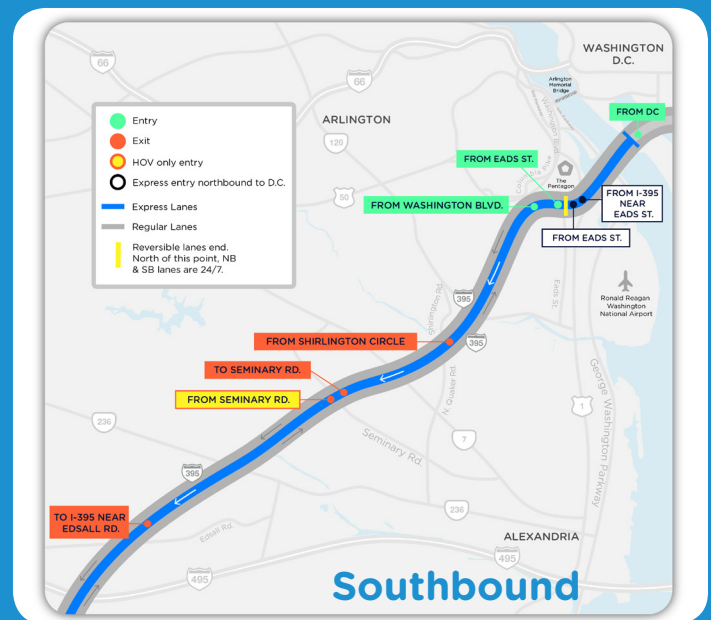
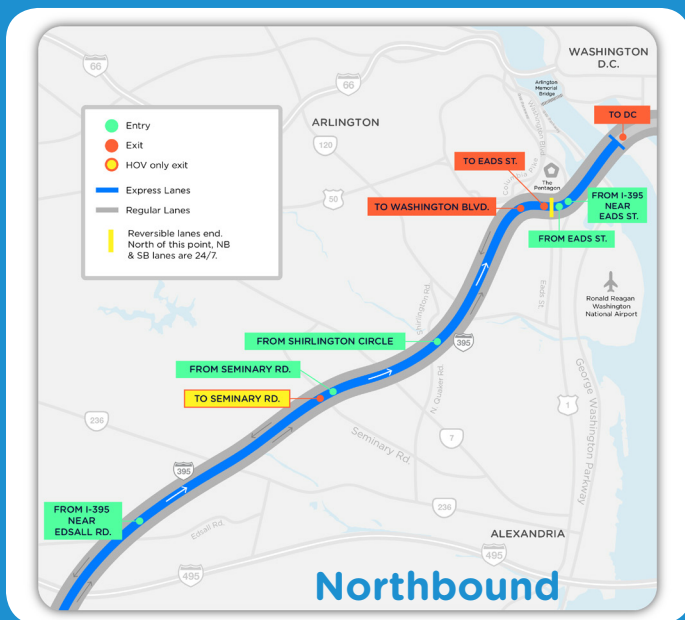


HOV-3: 1 + 2 = Free

Whether you carpool, vanpool or slug, if you have 3 or more people and an E-ZPass set to HOV ON, you can drive the Express Lanes for free at any time.

It's a great way to get a faster trip and save money.

The Seminary Road south ramp is HOV-only at all times but you need an E-ZPass Flex -- so carpoolers, enjoy the road anytime.



Before hitting the road, take a look at the new Lanes on I-395. Existing HOV entry and exit points on the I-395 HOV lanes will become Express Lanes entry and exit points available for all customers. The only exception is the Seminary Road ramp that faces south, which will stay HOV only.
