SUBJECT: Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall (JBM-HH) Policy Memorandum ES-6, Fort McNair Parking on Days of Nationals Stadium and Audi Field Events

1. REFERENCE. JBM-HH 190-15, Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall Uniform Traffic Policy, 16 Jul 10.
2. PURPOSE. This policy applies to all individuals who enter Fort McNair on the day of a scheduled event at Nationals Stadium or Audi Field.
3. APPLICABILITY. This policy letter applies to all DoD ID card holders (active, reserve, retiree, dependent and civilian employee including civilian contractors) working within the JBM-HH, which consists of Fort Myer, Henderson Hall and Fort McNair.
4. POLICY.

a. In order to minimize disruption to the installation and its partners, parking on Fort McNair on days of scheduled events at Nationals Stadium or Audi Field will be restricted as follows:

(1) On the non-Federal holiday, non-weekend day (regular duty day) of a scheduled event at Nationals Stadium or Audi Field, prior to 1630 hours entrance and parking will be restricted to those vehicles whose operators have official business on the installation.

(2) On the Federal holiday or weekend (non duty days) day of a scheduled event at Nationals Stadium or Audi Field, individuals may park their vehicle in non-reserved spots on Fort McNair at any time, if one of the vehicle's occupants possesses a valid, current DoD ID card (active, reserve, retiree, dependant, or civilian employee).

b. Parking on days when there are major installation events is limited to those individuals who have official business on the installation or who are attending the event. There will be no "Nationals Stadium or Audi Field Parking" on those days.
