## Responsibilities

Sunik, an Akima Company, is seeking an **Environmental, Health & Safety (EHS) Manager to support a facilities operations and maintenance services contract that oversees critical operations at Marine Corps Base Quantico**. The manager will be responsible for inspection and enforcement of company EHS policies, environmental sampling (water, wastewater, soil, and air) and will be an integral part of the local spill response team.

- Lead and train the organizations spill response team. Must understand the local spill prevention, control and countermeasure plan (SPCC) and recommend updates as needed.
- Proactively identify health, safety, and environmental hazards and implement effective controls to minimize risks. Assist in developing Job Hazard Assessments and inspect work activities against the JHA, local, and federal regulations.
- Conduct inspections of departments to ensure compliance with health, safety, and environmental procedures. Document inspection findings and implement effective corrective actions. Develop an inspection schedule by week & EHS topic.
- Assist the ESH manager in managing environmental programs; such as maintaining permits, ensuring compliance with ISO 14001, and managing hazardous waste collection and satellite accumulation areas, and sampling.
- Respond to incidents related to health, safety, and the environment and notify all pertinent company and customer staff. Investigates incidents and report findings to program management causes and actions to take to prevent re-occurrences.
- Interface with subcontractors on matters related to Environmental,

Health and Safety.

- Generate and submit reports related to health, safety, and environmental metrics and systems as required by management or regulation.
- Maintain all records related to safety, health, and environmental protection and as required by programs, policy, regulation, or contract clauses.
- Utilize incident reporting and other health, safety, and environmental systems as required by the Company.
- Other duties as assigned.

- HAZWOPER Certification (minimum 24 hour) or the ability to obtain upon hiring
- A minimum of three years' experience working as an EHS technician and spill response
- Two year of Environmental sampling in managing safety, health, and environmental programs
- Three year of safety inspection/auditing experience
- US citizenship with ability to obtain a US Government Clearance.
- Ability to stand, walk, reach, bend and sit for extended periods of time
- Experience with EM 385-1-1 and other DOD safety, health, and environmental regulations (preferred)
- Experience with ISO 14001 compliance (preferred)
