SUBJECT: Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall (JBM-HH) Policy Memorandum PW-4, National Historic Preservation Act

1. REFERENCES.

a. Title 54 U.S. Code (USC) §§ 300101 et seq., National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended through 2016.

b. Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 800, Protection of Historic Properties, as amended through 2004.

c. Army Regulation 200-1, Environmental Protection and Enhancement, 13 Dec 07.

2. PURPOSE. This memorandum aims to increase awareness of, and establish procedures for, compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and its implementing regulation, 36 CFR 800.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy is applicable to all federal or federally-assisted Undertakings occurring at Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall and its components, pursuant to the NHPA and implementing regulation 36 CFR 800. The provisions of the NHPA address federal agency responsibilities when their activities involve properties listed in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) or properties eligible for listing in the NRHP. In particular "Section 106" (formally Section 306108) of the NHPA requires that federal agencies, prior to the approval of an Undertaking, take into account the effects of the Undertaking upon NRHP-listed or eligible properties.

4. POLICY. The spirit and direction of the nation are founded upon, and reflected in, its historic heritage. Therefore, all federal Undertakings at Fort Myer, Fort McNair, and Henderson Hall shall comply with the NHPA, Sections 306108 and 306101 (former Sections 106 and 110, respectively).

5. PROCEDURES. For all Undertakings at JBM-HH compliance with federal regulations in the NHPA, specifically "Section 106," and the implementing regulations is required. Procedures for compliance are detailed in 36 CFR 800 "Protection of Historic Properties," Subpart B.



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6. PROPONENT. The JBM-HH Directorate of Public Works, Environmental Management Division is the proponent for this policy. The POC is the Environmental Management Chief at (703) 696-8055.
