SUBJECT: Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall (JBM-HH) Policy Memorandum DFMWR-1, Support for Scouting Organizations

1. REFERENCE. Army Regulation 210-22, Private Organizations on Department of the Army Installations, 22 Oct 01.

2. PURPOSE. To establish policy for limited support provided to scouting organizations on JBM-HH, which includes Forts Myer, McNair, and Henderson Hall.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to every service member, civilian employee, family member, and visitor to Joint Base Myer-Henderson Hall.

4. POLICY. There are currently no scouting organizations established as private organizations within JBM-HH. Only limited fund-raising is authorized. This authorization does not imply any Federal, Army, or JBM-HH official endorsement of scouting activities.

5. PROCEDURES. Requests for conducting fund-raising activities are reviewed and approved by the Director of Family, Morale, Welfare and Recreation (DFMWR). Generally, requests are to permit cookie sales and popcorn in front of the Post Exchange and/or Commissary. An approval letter from the DFMWR permits direct coordination with these two agencies for conducting these events.

6. PROPONENT. The JBM-HH DFMWR is the proponent for this policy. The pointof-contact is the DFMWR Non-Appropriated Fund Financial Management Office at (703) 696-0581 or DSN 426-0581.
