


Configuring New Facebook for a More Secure Social Networking Experience


Although your privacy settings should copy to New Facebook, this is a good time to review your Facebook privacy settings.





If you block a user, that user will no longer be able to:

- See your posts.
- Tag you.
- Invite you to events or groups.
- Message you.
- Add you as a friends.
- Access your profile.




