

# AEROSOL CANS

401 KAR 43 and 40 CFR 273.6

## POSSIBLE AREAS OF CONCERN

Aerosols are under pressure and may contain hazardous chemicals. Disposal of aerosol cans will only be handled by the Hazardous Waste section.


## CHARACTERIZATION

Aerosol cans that are no longer needed or unserviceable (e.g., broken nozzle), but are still under pressure and/or still contain chemicals, must be collected and turned in at the hazardous material collection connex for proper disposal or reuse.

## HANDLING PROCEDURES

- Step 1** Aerosol containers must be stored in a flammable storage cabinet/connex.
- Step 2** Ensure aerosol cans are properly labeled to identify contents, remove the barcode label and turn-in the label to the HMSO.
- Step 3** Turn in empty and unusable aerosol cans to the hazardous material collection connex. See Appendix E for guidance.

**NOTE:** Only national stock numbered (NSN) items that are in original unopened depot packaging, and have not expired, will be accepted at the HMSO.
