

# SPILL RESPONSE MATERIALS

40 CFR 112.8 and KPDES Permit Section 3

## POSSIBLE AREAS OF CONCERN

Having the proper spill response material available.

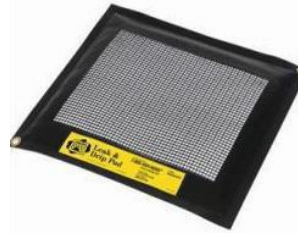
## CHARACTERIZATION

It may be necessary to conduct monthly inventories of your spill materials to ensure serviceability and availability. Hazardous materials storage areas and units conducting field training exercises will maintain an adequate supply of spill response materials.

## HANDLING PROCEDURES

### DRIP PADS

Vehicles (leaking only)  
Equipment (leaking only)  
Make arrangements to repair leaks



### SPILL CONTAINMENT PALLETS

Drums (55 Gallon)  
Batteries  
Chemical Containers (5 Gallon)



### WHITE PADS AND SOCKS

Pads will float for light oil sheens on water  
Socks will absorb POL liquids but not water  
Use around storm or sewer drains



### GRAY PADS AND SOCKS

Socks will absorb ALL liquids  
Will not float



**DO NOT PLACE AROUND STORM DRAINS—  
WILL HOLD WATER**
