OSHA Known Hazard / Legal Obligation

Employer

- Employers obligation to workers create work environment free of hazards or potentially hazardous.
- Employers must maintain **walking - working surfaces**, and keep them free of hazards such as **snow** and ice. (29 CFR 1910.22.(a)(2))

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Employee's Obligation

- Report and or Mitigate Known Hazards
- Prevent Slip and Fall hazards in the Work Environment
- If the Floor is Wet, Correct by Mopping, or Mitigating with Signage
- Use Caution When Walking in and Around Slippery Surfaces such as Wet Surface or Snow, and Ice
- Do Your Part
- Safety is Everyone's Business
- Complete Required Safety Training
