## BEE SMART!

- 1. Bees flap their wings more than 200 times in a second
- 2. In their 6-8 week lifespan, worker bees will fly the equivalent distance of 1 ½ times the circumference of the Earth.
- 3.A single bee will produce about 1/12 of a teaspoon of honey in its lifetime.
- 4. Bees, though jointed, do not have knees
- 5. There are three types of bees in every hive: a queen, worker bees, and drones.
- 6. Honey bees are taught how to make honey by older bees in the hive
- 7. A single hive can produce anywhere from 60 to 100 pounds of honey every year.
