


FORT KNOX HISTORIC DRIVING TRAIL SPOTTER INFORMATION

- 1** The Army Education Center was constructed in 1919 on the 2nd School Yard. Today, the center of learning by the Department of the Army is a part of the Army's Education Program.
- 2** The Main Post Chapel was constructed in 1899 to serve the (Brevet) Catholic community and was originally named St. Patrick's. While the Army occupied the town in 1918, the church was used as a warehouse until 1919 when it became the Main Post Chapel. It is the oldest building on post and the only recognized building from the town.
