#### **Army Emergency Relief**

#### Types of Assistance:

To Direct Access: All Soldiers have the ability to apply for assistance without going through their Command;
 except: IET Soldiers, <12 months TIS, 2 assists in 12 months, "high risk" Soldiers</li>

 Quick Assist: Formerly "Command Referral" Commanders and 1SGs have the authority to validate a need and grant assistance up to \$2,000

#### Authorized Categories of Assistance:

- Rent/Mortgage and Utilities/Deposits
- Emergency Travel and Travel Funds for Relocation
- Vehicle Repair and Replacement Vehicle/Rental Vehicle




