## Oily Water Filters



## What to do with your drip pans that have an oily water mixture?

It is illegal to pour oil and other petroleum products on the ground, down the drain connected to a sanitary sewer or in storm water drains. Facilities need to have the ability to properly dispose of contents that, if improperly discharged, could result in an illegal discharge of pollutants into waterways. Pour-through gravity filtration systems (Oily Water Filters) are the perfect solution. These systems provide the ability to absorb up to 33 gallons of oil-based liquid. Simply pour the liquid into the filter and filtered water flows out of the drain. Replaceable oil-only absorbent pillows are easy to change and can be rotated for maximum life. Just remember that this system is for filtering oil/water mixtures and not pure oil products. Used absorbent pillows can be bagged up and properly disposed of, in compliance with state and federal regulations, at the Fort Knox Landfill's contaminated material container located off Baker Road.
