MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: USAG-KA Policy 17- Roi-Namur Guest Sponsorship Policy and Kwajalein Residents Space Available

- 1. References. USAG-KA Regulation 190-10.
- 2. Purpose. The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance for overnight guest sponsorship for residents of Roi-Namur, and Kwajalein Space Available trips to Roi-Namur.
- 3. While the recovery effort remains a top priority for the installation, the improvements we have made to the infrastructure and resources allow us to reinstate overnight sponsorship privileges on Roi-Namur. This includes space available for Kwajalein residents and their families. Prohibition of unsponsored guests regardless of badge status remains in effect.
- 4. It is important to note that we are not at pre-January 2024 capabilities with limited number of MWR golf carts and recreational B-boats available for rental. Guests must:
 - a. Only Space-A availability to and from on Fly Roi.
 - b. Must be 21 years of age or older, if sponsoring in the 480 Program.
 - c. Billet in the sponsor's BQ, not to exceed billeting occupancy levels.
 - d. Limit stay with sponsor to 30 consecutive days or less for Roi residents.
 - e. Limited stay for Kwajalein residents visiting Roi up to 4 days.
 - f. Allow 30 days minimum to elapse between visits.
- 5. Additionally, the total on-island guests are Space A available. This number will change based on conditions and on-island capabilities.
