

Motorcycle Safety Training

How to enroll:

Step 1

Consult with your supervisor and unit motorcycle mentor for permissions and eligibility criteria. Ensure you have your Commander/Director authorization to attend the course before you enroll.

Step 2

Enrollment Procedures for US Army IMCOM Traffic Safety Training Program Courses

1. Go to CAC-enabled website https://imc.army.mil/airs/usg_disclaimer.aspx
2. Click on "I ACCEPT".
3. Under the heading you will find; Region, Garrison and Courses
4. Using the down arrow choose the following:
 - o Region "West"
 - o Garrison "Fort Leavenworth"
 - o Courses: Choose course that you want to enroll i.e. Basic, Experienced or Sport Bike Course
5. Click on calendar icon or "Next Month" to select dates and courses if course is full for that month.
 - o NOTE: Grayed out courses are past; courses in Red are filled; courses in Blue are available.
6. Click the desired date of course to enroll and follow the instruction.
 - o NOTE: Please read "Course Detail" for qualification/requirements, date and time of the course.
7. Once registration is complete, click "Save"
8. Attend the course you registered for, or cancel within 24hours of the scheduled course start, if you must cancel. No shows are reported to their unit chain of command.

Step 3

Show up prepared to train. The MC Safety classroom is temporarily located at 820 McClellan Avenue on the second floor of the Directorate of Public Works (DPW) Headquarters building 85, in conference room 101. Use the rear ground level entrance and proceed up the stairs to room 101. Student report time is 0730 for processing on the scheduled start day. Classes begin at 0800. The hands-on motorcycle riding portion of each course is conducted at the Bluntville Avenue Motorcycle Safety Course Riding Range. The range is located at 801 Bluntville Avenue in the large parking lot at the North end of building 429.
