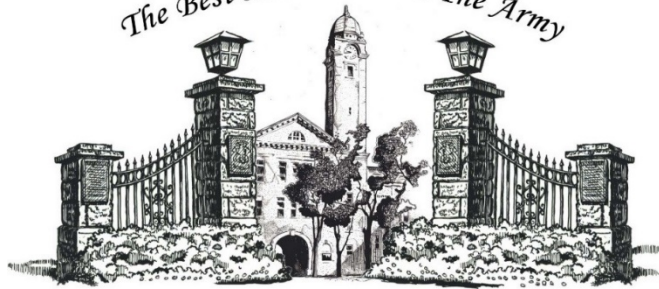

- April 29-May 12, Fort Leavenworth will conduct prescribed burn activities to reduce ground cover, to mitigate risks, and to improve conditions while controlling invasive species. The burn near the USDB will remove dead vegetation and increase visibility in the area, per request. It will also stimulate the warm season grass planted in the area enhancing erosion control and benefiting grassland nesting birds. Burning the prairies will stimulate native vegetation in those areas and fulfill recommendations from the Kansas Biological Survey and objectives of the Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan.
