Maintenance Mechanics at the WG-9 level typically will:

- Perform repair, replacement and maintenance tasks in the areas of carpentry, plumbing and electrical work.
- Determine materials needed and make repairs or replace items found defective.
- Operate vehicles up to and including 1-ton trucks to transport personnel, equipment and supplies to work sites.

Candidates will be evaluated in accordance with the qualification requirements set forth by the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) located at

- 1) Must possess or be able obtain a background check to determine suitability for Federal employment.
- 2) Position requires the completion of a pre-employment Physical Examination and an annual examination thereafter.
- 3) Employee must possess or obtain and maintain a valid state driver's license.
- 4) Position has a requirement to lift up to 60 lbs and up to 100 lbs with assistance.
- 5) Employee is required to walk, stand, stoop, bend, kneel, climb ladders and scaffolds, and work in tiring and uncomfortable positions.
- 6) Works inside and outside, occasionally in unheated buildings or outside in inclement weather.
- 7) Exposed to dirt, dust, grease, foul odors, paint fumes. Is subject to cuts and bruises and from hand and powered tools, minor electric shock, and danger of falls from ladders.
